U.S. gasoline prices continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.49 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.18 a gallon, up 5.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain states and Gulf Coast region at 2.23 a gallon.
