U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$2.83 a gallon on Monday. That's up 4.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.59 a gallon, up 29.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.53 a gallon, up 6-tenths of a penny.
