## **U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)**

---

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to \$2.26 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1 ½ cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 2.68 a gallon, up 4-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 2.04 a gallon, up half a penny.
