U.S. gasoline prices fall to lowest level since January 2011 (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to its lowest level since January 2011 at \$3.12 a gallon on Monday. That's down 8.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
