## **U.S. gasoline prices continue to decrease – Reaches lowest national average since April 2009 (short version)**

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline fell to its lowest level since April 2009 to \$2.04 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
