Gasoline prices continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.60 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.7 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.88 a gallon, up 2.8 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.39 a gallon, up 4.9 cents.
