U.S. gasoline prices increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.69 a gallon on Monday. That's up 1.2 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 4.00 a gallon, up 4-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.43 a gallon, up a penny.
