U.S. gasoline prices increase for first time in four weeks (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose 2 ½ cents from a week ago to \$3.22 a gallon on Monday. That's the first increase in four weeks, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
