

Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 7-tenths of a cent from a week ago to \$2.64 per gallon. That's up 52 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region remained at \$2.60 per gallon, up 54 cents from a year ago.
