Residential heating oil price increases

The average retail price for home heating oil rose 10.3 cents from a week ago to \$3.29 per gallon. That's down 93.7 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region rose to \$3.26 per gallon, up 10.4 cents from last week, and down 89.3 cents from a year ago.
