Residential heating oil price decreases

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 17.7 cents from a week ago to \$3.03 per gallon. That's down \$1.09 from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$2.99 per gallon, down 18.2 cents from last week, and down \$1.08 from a year ago.
