Residential heating oil price decrease

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 1.4 cents from a week ago to \$2.39 per gallon. That's down 4.4 cents from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region fell to \$2.33 per gallon, down 4-tenths of a cent from last week, and down 4.4 cents from a year ago.
