Residential heating oil prices virtually unchanged

The average retail price for home heating oil fell 4-tenths of a penny from a week ago to \$3.95 per gallon. That's down 8-tenths of a penny from a year ago, based on the residential heating fuel survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. Heating oil prices in the New England region rose 3.92 per gallon, up 3-tenths of a cent from last week, and up 3 cents from a year ago.
