Subject: Royalty Estimate Balance Report (Report)

The Minerals Management Service (MMS) provides the enclosed Report annually. All accepted estimate transactions as of June 18, 1997, appear on this Report. Please review it for accuracy and completeness.

Payers are responsible for determining the accuracy of their estimate balance(s). Balances are established with each estimate transaction (Transaction Code 03) reported on your Report of Sales and Royalty Remittance (Form MMS-2014). Information on establishing/changing estimates is provided in the *MMS Oil and Gas Payor Handbook*, Volume II, pages 3-113 through 3-120.

The Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Simplification and Fairness Act of 1996 (RSFA) provides for interest to be paid on overpayments. However, this may not apply to overpaid estimated payments if your total overpayments exceed 10 percent of the royalties paid that month. Therefore, there is additional incentive to review the enclosed Report and bring all estimates in line with current production.
