Tech Note 1 is a rangeland and grazed forest seeding guide for eastern Oregon and Washington. The seeding guide, in the form of a Microsoft Access 2007 database, provides seeding suggestions for conservation efforts east of the Cascade Mt. crest. The guide provides, common name, scientific name, seeds/lb, seeding rate, growth form, etc. for range and forestland species. Links to in-depth information on plant id, pasture species selection, range and pasture planning, seedbed preparation, seed quality, and drill calibrations are included. Links are also provided for information on western Oregon and Washington pasture and hayland species.
