Engineroom Resource Management and Leadership & Management Equivalency Reminder

CMES has received the following approval from the USCG's National Maritime Center.

Any unlimited horsepower licensed engineer successfully completing our *Upgrading Engineers Management Level* course and presenting any dated certificate of completion will:

- 1. Satisfy that portion of Section A-III/2, Table A-III/2, Function: Controlling the Operation of the ship and care for persons on board at the management level training requirements of the STCW Code, as amended, for certification of Chief Engineer Officers and First Assistant Engineers; AND
- 2. Satisfy the Leadership and Managerial Skills and ERM, if not completed at the operational level, course requirements for 46 CFR:
 - a. 11.325(a)(3)(i & ii) and 11.325(b)(1 & 2) for Chief Engineer (4000 hp)
 - b. 11.327(a)(3)(i & ii) and 11.327(b)(1 & 2) for Second Engineer Officer (4000 hp)
 - c. 11.331(a)(3)(i & ii) and 11.331(b)(1 & 2) for Chief Engineer (1000 to 4000 hp)
 - d. 11.333(a)(3)(i & ii) and 11.333(b)(1 & 2) for Second Engineer Officer (1000 to 4000 hp)
