1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 66551-1" to the label prior to releasing the product for shipment.
3. The submitted rebuttal to the acute toxicity review of the acute inhalation and dermal sensitization studies has been completed, and the results provided below.
  - a. The submitted acute inhalation study is **not acceptable** and a new study must be submitted within 120 days of the date of this letter.
  - b. The dermal sensitization study has been upgraded to ccre minimum and accepted. This product is **not** considered a sensitizer.
4. As put forth in the Agency letter dated 26 November 1993, the currently acceptable label language for biting flies must include a limitation regarding the product efficacy, as the efficacy data only support a biting fly claim that protection is limited to approximately one hour. The following label statement is appropriate to address this issue: For gnats, blackflies, and biting midges, hourly application may be necessary for adequate protection.

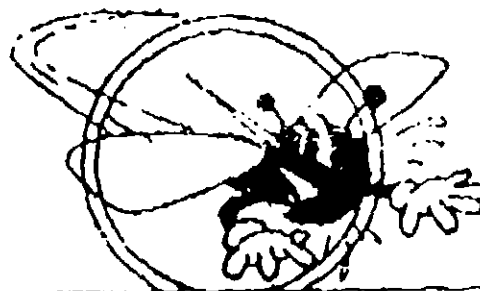
