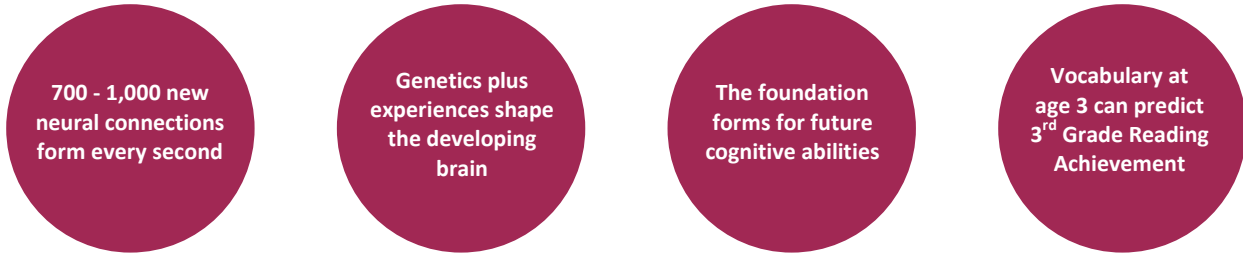

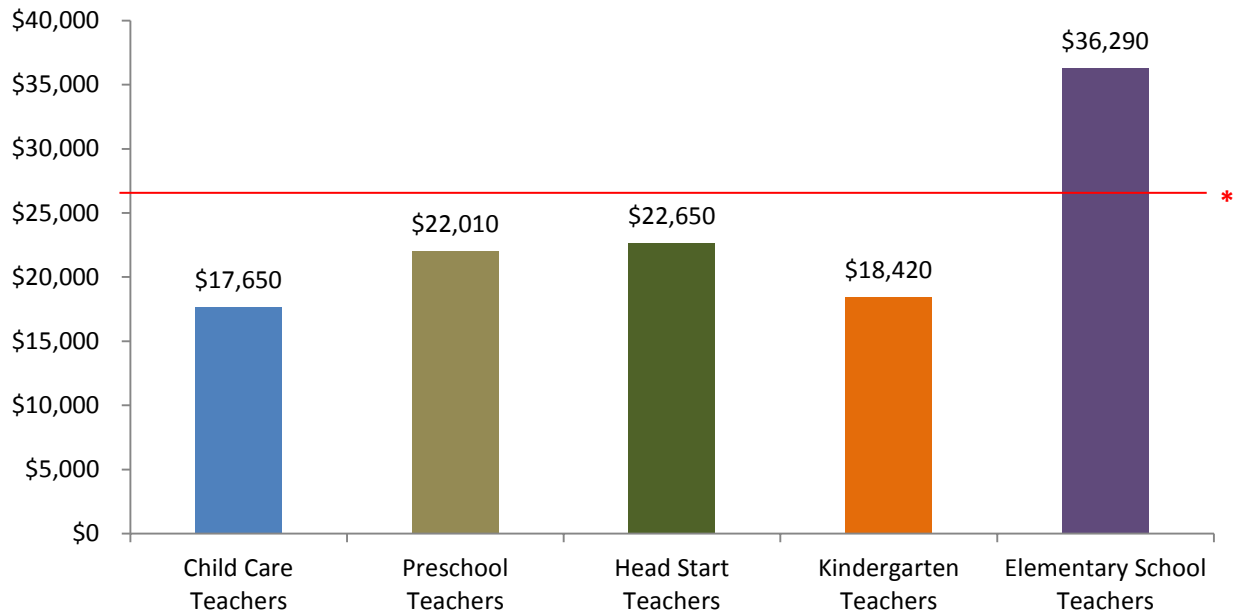
Access to High Quality Early Learning Matters!

Puerto Rico Median Annual Workforce Earnings

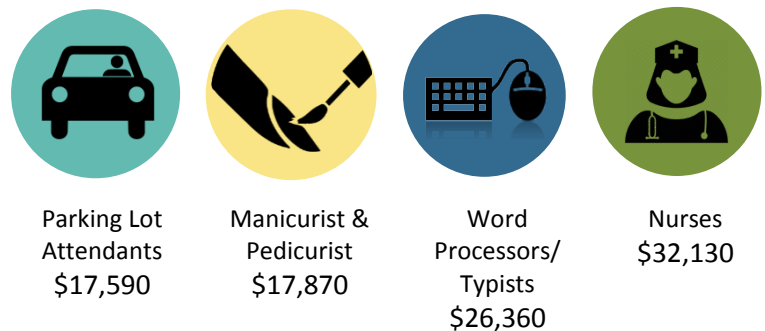

Puerto Rico Demographics

- 222,242** Children Under Age 6
- 184,852** Children Under Age 6 Below 200% of Poverty
- 61%** Children Under Age 6 Living in Households with All Parents Working
- 75.4%** Families Led by a Single Mother with Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
- 62.9%** Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
