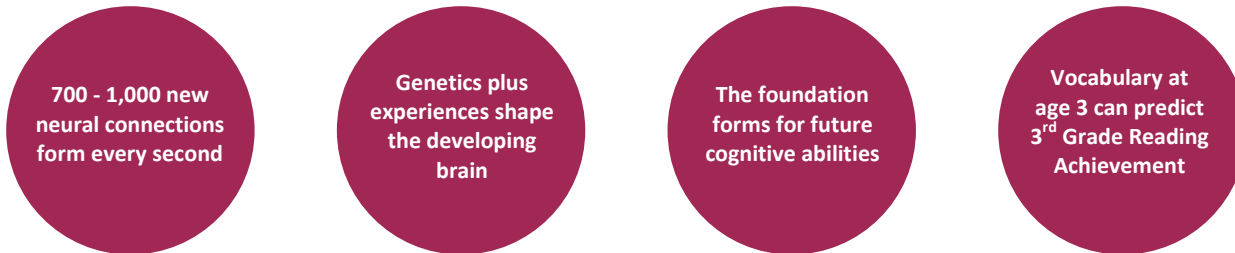

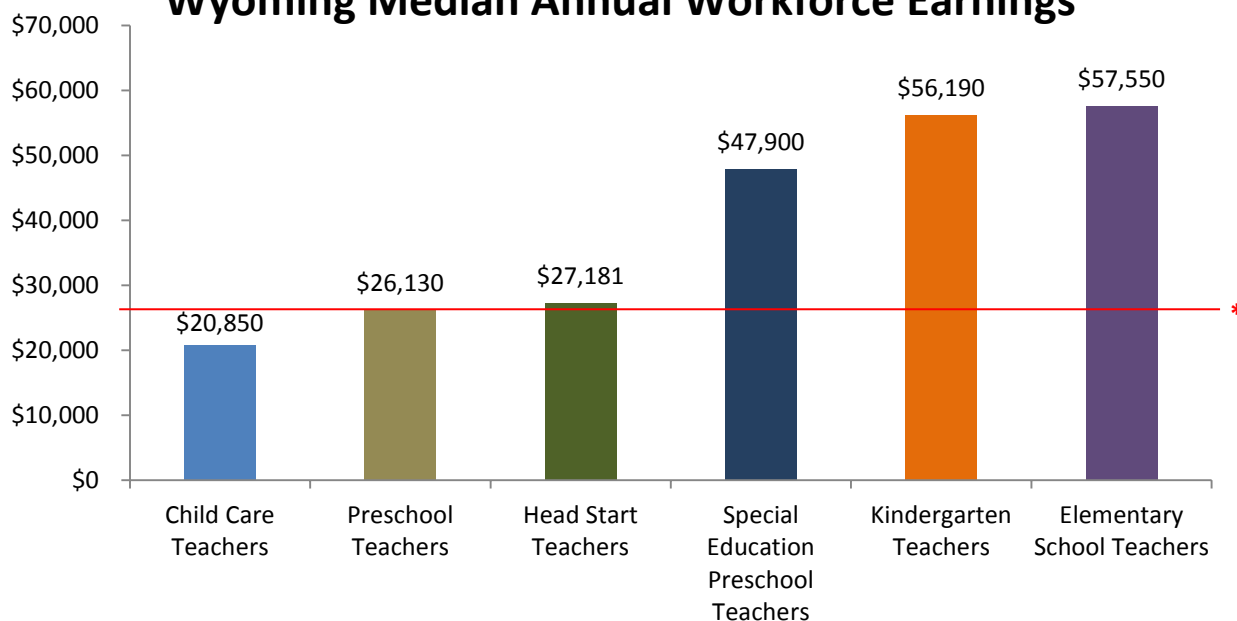
Access to High Quality Early Learning Matters!

Wyoming Demographics

- 45,620** Children Under Age 6
- 18,257** Children Under Age 6 Below 200% of Poverty
- 62%** Children Under Age 6 Living in Households with All Parents Working
- 36.5%** Families Led by a Single Mother with Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
- 14.2%** Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
