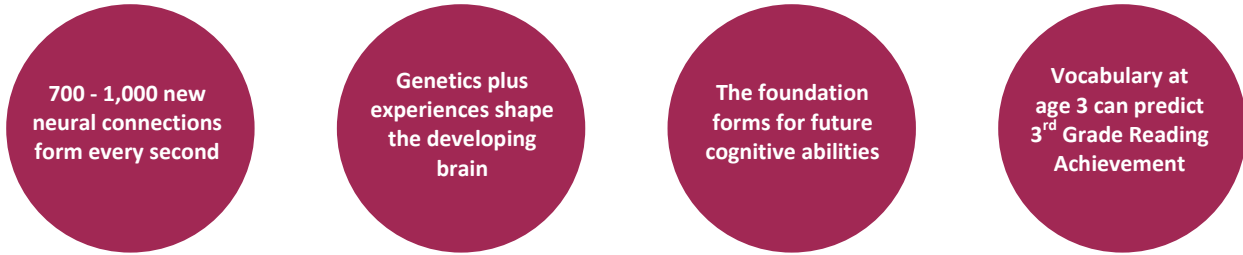

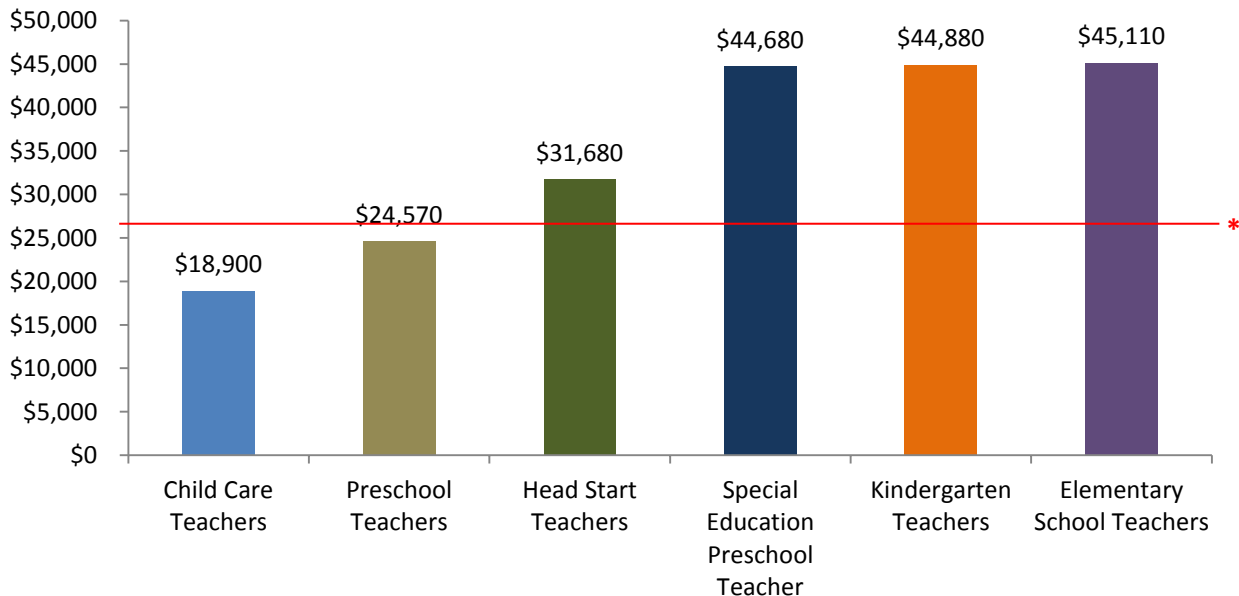
Access to High Quality Early Learning Matters!

High Quality Programs Depend on a Quality Workforce Low Wages Undermine Quality

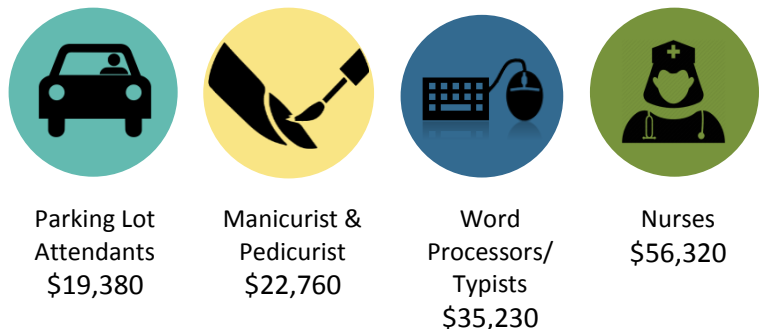
Kansas Median Annual Workforce Earnings
