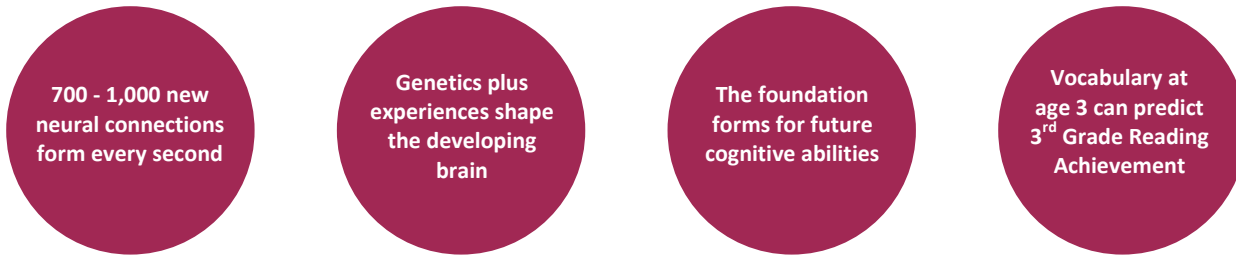

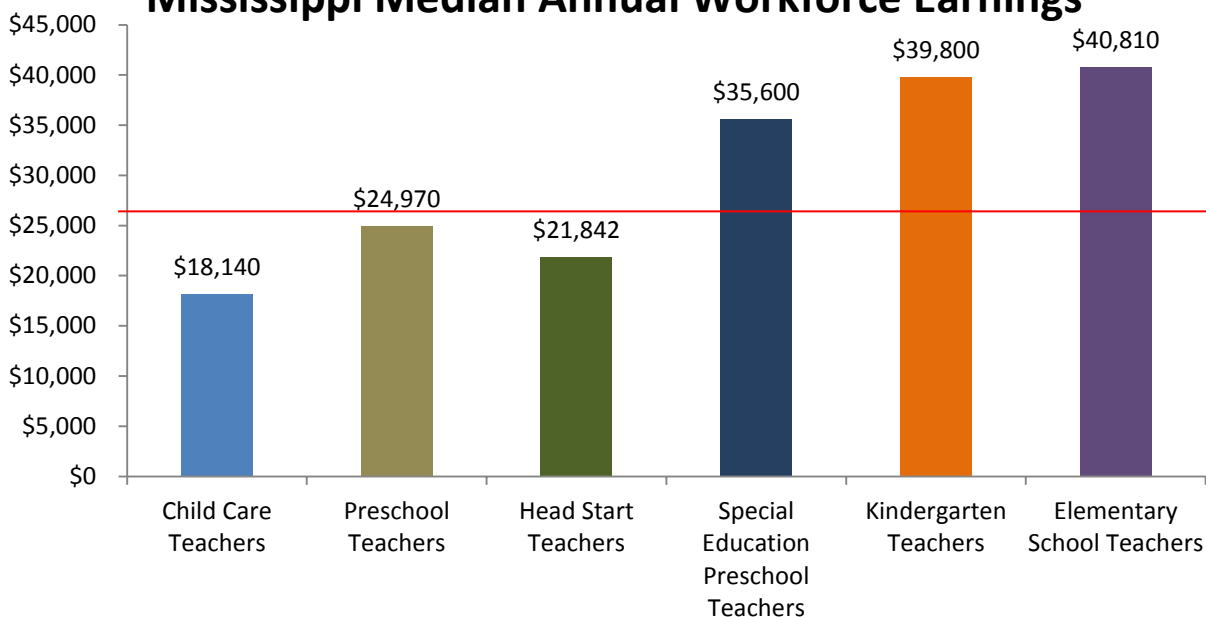

## High Quality Programs Depend on a Quality Workforce Low Wages Undermine Quality

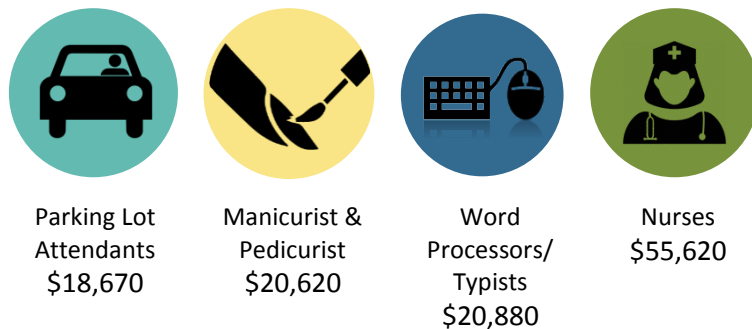
### Mississippi Median Annual Workforce Earnings

- 48.8%** Families Led by a Single Mother with Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
- 31.4%** Children Under Age 5 Living in Poverty
