Appendix F. Data and Methodology Changes

Tables and data files in the State Energy Data System (SEDS) supply a new year of data each production cycle. The latest data may be preliminary and, therefore, revised the following cycle. Changes made to consumption and price source data for historical years are also regularly incorporated into SEDS.

Listed below are changes in SEDS contents beyond the standard updates.

Petroleum

Asphalt and road oil

For 2009 forward, state-level production of hot-mix asphalt/warm-mix asphalt, excluding reclaimed asphalt pavement, are used to allocate national-level consumption to the states.

Liquefied petroleum gases (LPG)

For 2008 forward, the method of estimating LPG consumed by the industrial sector is revised to account for the use of propane as fuel and the use of propane, ethane, normal butane, and isobutane as petrochemical feedstocks.
