

# UNITED STATES COAST GUARD CUTTERS, BOATS, AND AIRCRAFT

## POLAR ICEBREAKERS

The Coast Guard requires a minimum of two new heavy icebreakers to recapitalize the existing fleet to support economic, commercial, maritime and national security needs. The new icebreakers will be national assets capable of executing nine of the Coast Guard's 11 missions and ensuring access to both polar regions. The ships will operate worldwide and face the range of extreme environmental conditions found in the polar, tropical and temperate regions. The polar icebreaker acquisition program completed operational requirements development in January 2016, and released high-level requirements and design parameters to industry.

## OFFSHORE PATROL CUTTERS

The offshore patrol cutter will provide a critical capability between the fast response cutter's near-shore patrol capabilities and the national security cutter's ability to act as a high-endurance, open-ocean command and control platform. The OPC will replace the service's 210-foot and 270-foot medium endurance cutters, which have been in service for 25 to 50 years. The Coast Guard is pursuing a two-phased design-build strategy, with a focus on affordability, to acquire the OPC.

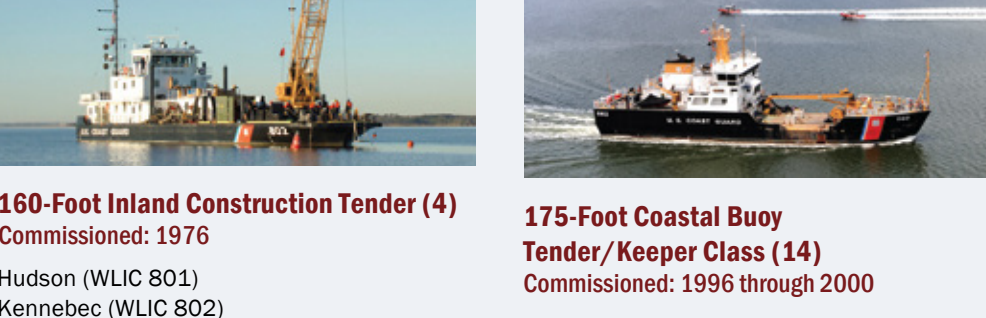
