## Introduction

#### **CURRENT POPULATION REPORTS**

The Current Population Report series has long been recognized as an important source of demographic information on a wide variety of population-related topics. This index is a reference source for data users of the Current Population Reports and is designed to provide a ready resource for each subject with the relevant reports listed sequentially by series number and title. This guide lists subjects covered in these reports, but does not indicate all cross-classifications (e.g., by age, race, Hispanic origin¹, or sex) or the historical data shown in some tables.

A substantial amount of the current population data from the Census Bureau is derived from the Current Population Survey (CPS), the Survey of Income and Program Participation (SIPP), and the Population Estimates and Projections program.

The format of the series identifiers is as follows: a P followed by the series number, a dash, and the report number (e.g., P20-463). The following abbreviated symbols will appear with the titles of some reports, to further enhance the information given in the title.

Code definition:

- (A) Advance Report
- (RD) Research and Development Report
- (RV) Revised Report
- (SIE) Survey of Income and Education Report

#### **Current Population Survey**

The CPS is a household sample survey of the civilian noninstitutional population of the United States. Its primary task is to produce monthly statistics on unemployment and the labor force, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics in its monthly bulletin, "Employment and Earnings." The CPS also serves as a vehicle for supplemental studies on subjects other than employment. From the basic and supplemental data, the Census Bureau issues the following series of publications:

1. P20: Population Characteristics

2. P23: Special Studies

3. P60: Consumer Income

<sup>1</sup>Persons of Hispanic origin can be of any race.

Users can order series subscriptions or purchase individual reports. CPS microdata files on computer tape and CD-ROM also are available.

Occasionally reports in the P20, P23, and P60 series are designated as "research/developmental" reports, as indicated by the notation "RD" in the identification number. Such reports cover information in the developmental stage, and not yet considered to be official statistics.

**P20:** Population—Regularly recurring reports in the P20 series contain data on geographical mobility, fertility, school enrollment, educational attainment, marital status, households and families, persons of Hispanic origin, voter registration and participation, and various other topics. Many of these reports show data by race. In 1989 regular reports on the Black population (formerly in Series P23) were added. Periodic reports on the Asian and Pacific Islander population began with information from March 1990 and 1991. The report on residents of farms and rural areas was added from Series P27 beginning with the 1988 report, but was discontinued after the 1991 publication. Also cited are those reports prepared in cooperation with other agencies such as the Bureau of Agricultural Economics.

**P23: Special Studies**—Information pertaining to methods, concepts, or specialized data is furnished in the publications in the P23 series. Also included are focused analyses of demographic subjects of topical interest and occasional reports on metropolitan-nonmetropolitan population, youth, women, the older population, and other topics.

**P60:** Consumer Income—Information concerning families, individuals, and households at various income and poverty levels is presented in the P60 series of reports. Data are also presented on noncash benefits (including health insurance), child support, and the relationship of income to age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, family size, education, occupation, work experience, and other characteristics.

#### **Survey of Income and Program Participation**

The SIPP is a longitudinal national survey conducted by the Census Bureau. Its principal purpose is to provide estimates of the economic situation of families and individuals. Recurrent questions deal with employment, types of income, participation in government programs and noncash benefits. Periodically, questions are added dealing with school enrollment, marital history, migration, child care, disability, and other topics. From time to time, special supplemental questions also are added.

The data from SIPP are available in reports (**P70: Household Economic Studies**), on microdata tape files, and on CD-ROM. Users may order individual reports or arrange an annual subscription.

#### **Population Estimates and Projections**

Population estimates and projections are presented in the following series of reports:

- 1. P25: Population Estimates and Projections
- 2. P26: Local Population Estimates
- 3. P28: Special Censuses.

P25: Population Estimates and Projections—Population estimates data include monthly estimates of the total U.S. population; annual midyear estimates of the U.S. population by age, sex, race, and Hispanic origin; States by age and sex; plus population totals for counties, metropolitan areas, and 36,000 cities and other local governments. The estimates for counties appeared in Series P26 during the 1970's and 1980's, as did estimates for the 36,000 local governments during the 1980's. Estimates for Puerto Rico and the outlying areas were published in Series P25 through the 1980's. The monthly U.S. population estimates formerly published in the P25 series are now available only through the Internet.

Projections of the U.S. and state populations are also included in the P25 series. Beginning in the 1980's, projections are available not only by age and sex, but also by race and Hispanic origin. There also can be occasional research/developmental reports in this series.

P26: Local Population Estimates—The P26 (Local Population Estimates) series was dedicated throughout the 1970's and 1980's to providing annual population estimates for counties and metropolitan areas, using standardized methodology mutually agreed on by the Census Bureau and the responsible State agency under the Federal-State Cooperative Program for Population Estimates. County and metropolitan area (MA) estimates from 1981 to 1985 were released in individual State reports. Beginning in 1986, county estimates appeared in one comprehensive report and, beginning in 1988, MA estimates also were published in a single report for the year.

Beginning in 1982, biennial population and per capita income estimates for counties and 36,000 local government jurisdictions were also included. Previously such

estimates were provided in the P25 series. The 1982 estimates were published in individual State reports. Beginning in 1984, the estimates were released by State in five regional reports (Northeast, East North Central, West North Central, South, and West).

The P26 series was discontinued after the 1988 reports, and the population estimates now appear in the P25 series, in the paper listings, and on the Internet.

**P28: Special Censuses**—This series is dedicated to reporting the results of special censuses taken by the Census Bureau between decennial censuses at the request and expense of localities. No report has been released in the series covering censuses taken since 1985, but listings of special census results appear for the later periods in the Population Paper Listing (PPL) series. A description of Special Censuses begins on page 52 of this report.

#### OTHER POPULATION REPORT SERIES

Information produced from the CPS, the SIPP, and the Population Estimates and Projections program is made available in various paper series in addition to Current Population Reports—Statistical Briefs and paper listings.

#### **Statistical Briefs**

The Census Bureau released its first Statistical Brief (identified by SB in the index) in 1986 as a means of releasing interesting information obtained from Census Bureau surveys and censuses in a concise (2 to 4 page), understandable, easy-to-read format. In the past, most Statistical Briefs were based on data published in a printed report. We are, however, moving toward releasing more data electronically rather than in a printed volume, and increasingly, Statistical Briefs are being produced based on unpublished data. This Subject Index to Current Population Reports and Other Population Report Series includes only those Statistical Briefs that are based on data from the CPS, the SIPP, or the Population Estimates and Projections program. For a full list of all Statistical Briefs, write to Robert Bernstein, Public Information Office, Bureau of the Census, Washington, DC 20233. The first two digits of the Statistical Brief number indicate the year of release.

#### **Paper Listings**

A series of paper listings was begun in 1994 to help ensure and provide a structure for timely data release. In the past, data listings like these were produced, but were never organized and announced publicly. Following several naming schemes (PPL's, ISBPL's, and POV-PL's), these listings are photocopies of data tables and

generally contain no analysis. As with the printed reports, the sources of data are the CPS, SIPP, and the Population Estimates and Projections program. Most Current Population Reports were reduced in physical size in 1995; PPL's provide the detailed data tables formerly available in the printed reports.

Eventually, data from selected paper listings may be archived in printed reports; other items, especially those likely to undergo successive revisions (e.g., population estimates) may be released only in this paper listing format.

#### **Electronic Media**

Internet is rapidly becoming the primary release medium for Census Bureau information. Most of the recent (1995 forward) data releases, including Current Population Reports and Statistical Briefs, are available through the Internet (http://www.census.gov/).

The paper listings are frequently available as files on the Internet and computer diskette.
