## WHAT IS IVY SOFTWARE?

The College of Business is now working with a new partner, Ivy Software, to offer self-paced, online course modules, to serve as an alternative route to completing background course deficiencies for the MBA and MS degrees. Students with background course deficiencies may use the modules administered by Ivy Software as an alternative to enrollment in traditional background courses at UNT (below). Courses being offered by Ivy Software and their equivalent background courses include:

Courses offered by Ivy Software are 100% online. Students have 120 days to complete each course and must earn a grade of 80% to meet the background deficiency requirement. Ivy Software courses are competitively priced at \$60 each. Completed courses are used to show competency in a specific core area. They will not be noted as complete on a UNT official transcript and are not financial aid eligible. ### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Students with business core deficiencies may use courses administered by Ivy Software as an alternative to enrollment in traditional courses at UNT. Students enrolling in Ivy Software courses will be asked to acknowledge all of the requirements below before registering and beginning coursework.

Ivy courses require a minimum grade of 80.

Ivy courses cannot be repeated. Students not passing an Ivy course with a grade of 80 are required to enroll in the equivalent UNT background course.

Ivy courses have a completion time limits of 120 days from the first date of enrollment in the Ivy course.

Ivy courses are not UNT courses and will not be posted to a UNT transcript. Ivy courses are only used meet background course deficiencies of the UNT College of Business.

Ivy courses are not eligible for financial aid.

Student must be enrolled at UNT at least half time to be financial aid eligible.

Ivy courses are not used when determining enrollment status for federal financial aid or immigration.
