Criteria for Associate Membership³

• Academically Qualified Status <u>OR</u> Professionally Qualified

Status with PhD

¹According to UNT policy full members "may teach graduate level courses, serve as members of master's advisory committees, serve as members of dissertation committees or D.M.A. advisory committees, serve as major professors or co-major professors for master's and doctoral degree students, serve as major professors or <u>directors for</u> <u>master's theses, doctoral dissertations</u> ..."

²To maintain Academically Qualified status, faculty members must earn at least 10 points in these activities in any given five year period. Further, the expectation is that Academically Qualified faculty will have at least one refereed publication during the five year period."

³Associate members may "<u>teach graduate level courses</u>, serve as members of master's advisory committees, serve as <u>members of dissertation committees</u>.."

*Criteria indicate requirements for <u>eligibility</u>. Departments can decide which eligible faculty to nominate. Similarly, departments can establish rules for chairing dissertations (e.g., requiring co-chair experience).
