#### DETAILS OF EVENT:

On 10/08/2012 at about 11:12 P.M. a white male victim was walking from campus to his vehicle parked near 1520 W. Hickory. The suspect vehicle, driven by an unidentified female, pulled up to the victim.

The front seat passenger (suspect) exited the vehicle and demanded the victim's money. The victim refused to release his property and the suspect and suspect vehicle departed the area.

#### Suspect Description:

Hispanic male, approx. 20 Years Of Age, 5-foot 8-inches, thin build, short cropped hair, chin facial hair. Wearing a white basketball shirt and basketball shorts.

## The suspect was displaying an unknown type black handgun during the robbery attempt.

The victim stated that the suspect vehicle was occupied by two other unknown subjects sitting in the back seat. There are no descriptions for either of them or the female driver.
