Faculty Senate Charter Approved Changes on Faculty Senate Student Participation February 2014

Article II. Composition of the Faculty Senate

Section 4. There shall be two UNDERGRADUTE STUDENTS one elected by the Student Government Association, and one GRADUATE STUDENT elected by the Graduate Student Council (modified 05-1998). These STUDENT senators shall have the status of observers, with the rights of speaking and serving with the right to vote on committees of the Faculty Senate, but they shall not have the right to vote on decisions of the Faculty Senate as a whole.

Article III. Terms, Qualifications and Elections

Section 4. Qualifications for STUDENT senators shall be the attainment of 45 semester hours for undergraduate students, and 18 semester hours for graduate students by the time of election.
