## WHAT IS IVY SOFTWARE?

Ivy Software is a College of Business partner that offers self-paced, online course modules to serve as an alternative route to completing background course deficiencies for the MBA and MS degrees. Students with background course deficiencies may use the modules administered by Ivy Software as an alternative to enrollment in traditional background courses at UNT (See Chart Below).

## WHAT IS RESPONSIVE.NET?

Responsive.net is a College of Business partner that offers mathematical assessments and tutorials that serve as an alternative route to completing business calculus. Students with a background course deficiency in business calculus may use the Responsive.net module as an alternative to enrollment in business calculus at UNT and refer back to course tutorials for one-year. Courses offered by Ivy Software and Responsive.net are 100% online. Students have 120 days to complete each course and must earn a grade of 80 percent to meet the background deficiency requirement. Ivy Software courses are competitively priced at \$60 each. Responsive.net charges \$48 for Quantitative Foundations. Completed courses are used to show competency in a specific core area. They will not be noted as complete on a UNT official transcript and are not financial aid eligible.



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Students with business core deficiencies may use courses administered by Ivy Software and Responsive.net as an alternative to enrollment in traditional courses at UNT. Students enrolling in Ivy Software or Responsive.net courses should read the information below and acknowledge all requirements before registering and beginning coursework.

All courses taken require a minimum grade of 80.

Courses cannot be repeated without prior approval of the College of Business, Graduate Programs Office.

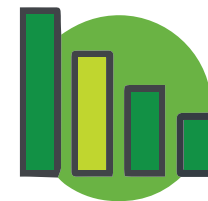
All courses have a completion time limit of 120 days from the first date of enrollment.

Ivy courses and Responsive.net courses are not UNT courses, will not be posted to a UNT transcript and are only used to meet deficiency content at UNT's College of Business.

Ivy software and Responsive.net courses are not eligible for financial aid.

Student must be enrolled AT UNT at least half time to be financial aid eligible.

Ivy courses and Responsive.net courses are not used when determining enrollment status for federal financial aid or immigration.
