Admission to Teacher Education

A post baccalaureate student must be admitted to the Teacher Education Program prior to the first semester of enrollment. To be admitted, a student must complete this form and pay the fee and

- pass the TASP/THEA with scores of 240 reading, 230 math, and 220 writing or appropriate substitute exam as listed in the current UNT catalog.
- be admitted to the Toulouse School of Graduate Studies as a Certification Only or Master's degree student;

Continuation in the Teacher Education Program is not guaranteed by the admission process.

Field Experiences

Students will participate in supervised practicum, internship or student teaching (in certain cases the student may teach two years under contract at the level and in the subject of the target certificate.) UNT and certain participating school districts may require a criminal history check prior to field experience.

Recommendation for Teacher Certification

To be recommended for certification, the student must have paid all applicable fees and have

- been Admitted to Teacher Education;
- successfully completed all required academic courses on certification plan;
- successfully completed all required professional field experiences;
- maintained GPA requirements as stated on his/her degree or certification plan;
- passed the required TExES exams.

Certification is completed by application to the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) through the College of Education at the University of North Texas (UNT). Although UNT recommends the student to the SBEC, the final authority to confer the teacher certificate remains with the SBEC. SBEC policy requires that each applicant complete the criminal history section on the application and have that evaluated by SBEC before certification is issued. UNT may share your information with the SBEC.
