
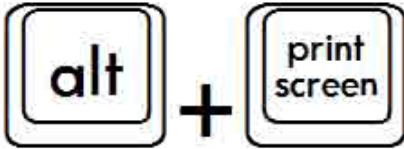





Capture a Screen in Windows XP

Copying what is on your monitor display is called a *screen capture*. You can do a screen capture by pressing the print screen key (PrtScn). You can then paste the screen capture into a document or other file. You can capture the entire screen or just the active window.

Step 1	<p>Press the print screen key (PrtScn) to capture the entire screen and put it on your clipboard.</p> <p>Press Alt and Print Screen at the same time to capture only the currently selected window and put it on your clipboard.</p>	 
Step 2	Open a program such as Microsoft Word or Microsoft Paint.	
Step 3	Paste the image into the program using Ctrl + V, right click and paste, or File-Paste.	
	Notes: Windows XP and earlier versions do not have the Snipping Tool that is available in Windows Vista and Windows 7.
