All non-keyboard majors must enroll in secondary piano each long semester until proficiency is passed (MUAG 1013 and MUAG 1014 may be waived by successful completion of Piano Proficiency Examination). Elective hours may be needed if student completes Piano Proficiency with lower than 2 credits of piano.

\*\*\* MUMH electives to be chosen from MUMH 4050, 4750, 4760, 4770, 4780, MUJS 4470, or MUET 4500. 9 hours total

\*\*\*\* These Elective hours may not be in music.

- Student must earn a grade of “C” or better in core English classes.

-Student must earn a grade of “B” or better in all Music History classes.

- Additional requirements include the Piano Proficiency Examination, Theory Proficiency, and Upper Division Exam.
