1. **Hours Required and General/College Requirements:** A minimum of 123 semester hours, of which 42 must be advanced.
2. **Grade Requirements:** All program courses and their transfer equivalents/substitutions must be completed with a grade of C or better to advance to Clinical I and II.
3. **GPA Requirements:** Program admission: 2.75 GPA in Core AND a 2.75 overall GPA. Graduation requirements: Students must have a 2.75+ GPA in the Core, Academic Major, and Pedagogy.
