## What is the Texas Success Initiative (TSI)?

TSI is a state law which requires students to demonstrate college readiness in reading, mathematics and writing before enrolling in college-level courses. Students may satisfy TSI requirements by achieving minimum passing standards on the TSI Assessment, or by qualifying for an exemption.

#### Who Must Test?

**ALL undergraduate students** who enter a Texas public institution of higher education MUST take the TSI Assessment prior to enrolling in any college-level coursework unless they meet an exemption in accordance with Texas law.

#### When Should I Test?

The TSI Assessment must be taken PRIOR to enrolling in courses.

#### **EXEMPTION IS NOT AUTOMATIC**

Students who are exempt must provide UNT Dallas Academic Support Services with a high school transcript, college transcript, or score report showing score and date taken before registration can take place. Military personnel will need a copy of their DD214.
