WHEREAS, particular scheduling requirements have been found to limit the efficacy of the Supreme Court;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court, students, and relevant parties are hindered by the limitation expressed in the SGA Bylaws Article IV, Section 1, Point D, which restricts the scheduling of hearing between the hours of 5pm and 9pm;

LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the following changes be made to the UNT SGA Bylaws:

Article IV, Section 1, Point D;

“D) Upon notification the court will have one week to begin hearings. Hearings must be held between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. and may not conflict with a previously scheduled SGA meeting.”
