- Survey results may not be changed or modified in any way.
- Survey results may not be used to solicit business.
- Survey results may not be placed on the Web without the explicit permission of CUPA-HR.
- Access to survey reports and DOD is limited to the institution purchasing the subscription. Sharing report information, log-in credentials, output from DOD analyses or DOD access with other institutions or organizations will result in immediate cancellation of access and will preclude future access. The system tracks and monitors use and users.
- o Institutions within a system, including the system office, are considered to be separate institutions relative to the use of CUPA-HR survey results. Results must be purchased separately by each institution and may only be shared within the purchasing institution. Results may not be shared with individuals at other institutions within the system or with the system office.
