

Lois Honeycutt Bodine Scholarship in Chemistry

Application

The Lois Honeycutt Bodine Scholarship is available for qualified students who are currently full time, or its equivalent, Chemistry majors. Student applicants can be either undergraduate or graduate students, with a minimum GPA of 3.0 To qualify, the following conditions must be met:

1. Must be a declared and listed major in Chemistry (undergraduate or graduate).
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a faculty member; it is the candidate's responsibility to see that the recommendation letter is supplied to the Scholarship Committee in time for evaluation.
3. Must have a record of outstanding scholarship.
4. A set of transcripts of all college work must accompany the application (The Chemistry Student Services Office can print your transcripts for you).
5. You must be enrolled at UNT in the upcoming Fall and Spring semesters.
