	• If you DO NOT qualify for any of <u>the exemptions found on our website or the back of this page</u> , you'll need to take the TSI Assessment as soon as possible. Move on to the next step.

	• If you earned below the scores on any given section, you'll meet with a TSI advisor during orientation before registering for classes. At that time, you'll learn about courses in which you are eligible to			
	enroll. If you did not earn the minimum scores, you may also take the assessment again.
