Orientation Steps

- ◇ New F-1 or J-1—Register and pay for International Graduate Student Orientation (\$45). Go on-line: international.unt.edu/orientation
- ◇ Register for Graduate Orientation (Session 1): studentaffairs.unt.edu/orientation-and-transition-programs/programs/orientation/graduate-orientation
- ◇ Attend International-Graduate Orientation (concurrent session)
- ◇ Must bring passport w/ US visa, UNT I-20 or DS-2019 and international fee payment (Order Number)
- ◇ Make sure Current/Local Address (place of residence while attending UNT) is updated in my.unt.edu -> Student Center
- ◇ All mandatory holds/blocks gone? Register for Classes on-line: my.unt.edu -> Student Center
- ◇ Make payment as soon as possible to finish registering for classes—payment options available
- ◇ *Don't forget!* TB Screening (starts after 12 days of classes) - call 940.565.2333 or book appointment on-line with UNT Student Health Center
- ◇ *Note:* Official transcripts must be submitted to UNT Admissions in Eagle Student Services Center (ESSC) 3rd Floor.
