Orientation Steps

- ◇ Undergraduate students– Choose a session for University orientation at my.unt.edu-> Student Center
- ◇ New F-1 or J-1 (undergrads & grads)—Register for International Student Orientation (\$45).
On-line: international.unt.edu/orientation
- ◇ Attend University Orientation and meet with Academic Advisor—Ugrads receive advising code
- ◇ New F-1 or J-1 (undergrads & grads)— Attend International Student Orientation (must have passport w/ US visa, **UNT** I-20 or DS-2019 and international orientation proof of payment)
- ◇ Make sure Current/Local Address (*place of residence while attending UNT*) is updated in my.unt.edu-> Student Center
- ◇ Take Texas Success Initiative (TSI) if needed—check your TSI status in MyUNT student portal
- ◇ All mandatory holds/blocks gone? Register for Classes on-line: my.unt.edu-> Student Center
- ◇ Make payment as soon as possible to finish registering for classes—payment options available
- ◇ *Don't forget!* TB Screening (starts after 12 days of classes) - call 940.565.2333 or book appointment on-line with UNT Student Health Center .
