

Pohl Recreation Center
Summer 2016 Executive Summary

The dates of this report are May 15 – August 12, 2016.

- **62,605 participations**
 - This counts each participant as many times as they used the facility.
 - This is a 12.64% (7,024) increase in participations compared with summer 2015 (55,581).
- **3,257 individual participants**
 - This number indicates that 3,257 people used the facility 62,605 times.
- **2,901 individual students**
 - This counts every enrolled student that used the facility. This number is subtracted from the **individual participants** above.
 - This indicates that 356 of the individual participants were not UNT students.
 - 20% of all UNT students used the Rec Center.
- **Student Characteristics**
 - Of the 2,901 student users, 389 are enrolled full time and 2,512 are enrolled part time.
 - 18% of full-time UNT students used the Rec Center.
 - 20% of part-time UNT students used the Rec Center.
 - 1,747 student users are male (60%), and 1,154 are female (40%).
 - University of North Texas Student profile: 6,591 are male (45%), and 8,101 are female (55%).
 - 28% of all Freshmen used the Rec Center, 22% of all Sophomores used the Rec Center, 23% of all Juniors used the Rec Center, and 20% of all Seniors used the Rec Center.
 - 66% of First Time In College students used the Rec Center.
- **Ethnicity of Student Users**
 - 41% of the student users were Caucasian, 16% of the student users were African-American, 20% of the student users were Hispanic, 7% of the student users were Asian American.
 - The facility had a higher percentage of African American, Hispanic, and Asian American students than UNT enrollment.
 - The facility had a lower percentage of Caucasian students than UNT enrollment.
- **Residence of Student Users**
 - 28% live in Denton City, 10% live in Denton County (outside of Denton City) and 62% live outside of Denton County.
 - 30% of all UNT students who live in Denton City use the Rec Center
- **GPA of Student Users**
 - This compares the average GPA of the facilities' student users to the average GPA of the University non users. For each classification level, the GPA of **Rec Center users was higher than non-users.**
 - Freshmen: 2.87 Users, 2.82 Non-Users
 - Sophomores: 2.83 Users, 2.75 Non-Users
 - Juniors: 2.93 Users, 2.87 Non-Users
 - Seniors: 3.01 Users, 3.00 Non-Users
