Students **will not** be able to register for the required Methodologies (AEAH 4800) and Senior Seminar courses (AEAH 4848) without a degree plan on file.

MINORS FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS

While a foreign language is recommended as the minor, particularly for students who anticipate pursuing graduate studies in Art History, students may select another minor. All art history majors are required to complete a foreign language through the sophomore year.

CAPSTONE COURSE FOR ART HISTORY MAJORS

Art History majors must successfully complete Senior Seminar (AEAH 4848) in order to graduate. Students must have successfully completed Art History Methodologies (AEAH 4800) in order to register for Senior Seminar. Like Senior Seminar, Methodologies is offered in Fall semesters only.

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN OFFICIAL DEGREE PLAN ON FILE BEFORE THE SEMESTER THEY PLAN TO GRADUATE MAY NOT APPLY FOR GRADUATION.
