ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students applying to the MS in Accounting with a focus on Corporate Accounting must have successfully completed all accounting backgrounds courses before applying to the program. A student must have a minimum accounting GPA of 3.0 in order to be considered for the MS in Accounting with a concentration in Corporate Accounting.

BACKGROUND COURSES/CONTENT

The College of Business Graduate Programs Office works with students to determine if background deficiency courses will be necessary. Background content might include Financial and Managerial Ac-counting, Business Information Systems, Statistics, Business Law, Finance, Marketing, Micro and Macro Economics, Operations Man-agement and Calculus. Deficiencies can be completed via traditional academic coursework or through Ivy Software and Responsive.net. Ivy Software and Responsive.net deliver self-paced online learning modules that provide the needed background content without the need to formally enrolling in courses at UNT.
