- ** MULB 1808, 1817, 1818, 1819, 1820 Jazz Lab (6 semesters, minimum), MULB 18## (other than jazz lab, 2 semesters). Each student with a major in music must participate in a large ensemble (MULB) each long semester/term.
- *** Jazz drumset (percussion) concentration students take MUAG 1117 instead of MUJS 1131. Jazz guitar concentration students do not take MUJS 1131 or MUJS 1132.

ADDITIONALLY...

- “Applied Lessons” refers to accepted concentration-level lessons on auditioned instrument.
- Student must earn a grade of “C” or better in core English classes.
- Student must earn a grade of “B” or better in all Jazz classes.

- Additional requirements include the Piano Proficiency Examination, Upper Divisional Examination, Theory Proficiency Examination, Improvisation Competency Exam, and Final Improvisation Proficiency Exam.
- Students must pass the Jazz Concentration Proficiency in their concentration instrument.
