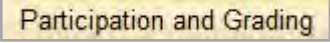
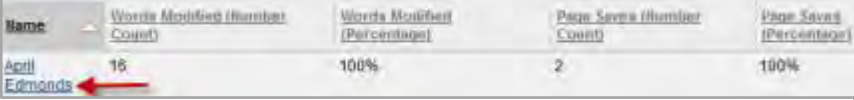

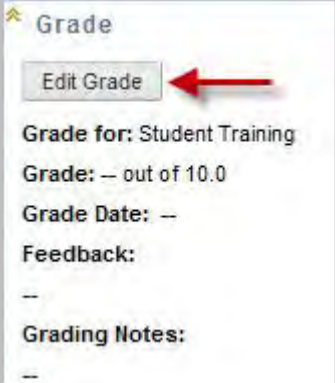
Commenting

<p>Step 1</p>	<p>Click on the content area by clicking on it in the course menu</p> <p>Click on Wikis.</p>	
<p>Step 2</p>	<p>Click on a Wiki topic.</p>	
<p>Step 3</p>	<p>Click Comment following the student's contribution. The Comment text box appears.</p>	
<p>Step 4</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Type a comment in the Comment text box. Click Spell Check at the bottom of the Comment text box to check the spelling of the content before continuing. Click Add.

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View Participation

Step 1	From the Wiki topic page. Click on Participation and Grading .																							
Step 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the Participation Summary page, view participation for the Students who have contributed to the Wiki. • In the side panel, view information about the Wiki and select a student to view his or her Participant's Contribution page. • Page Versions: The Page Version column displays all pages created and edited by the student. A new version is created each time a page is edited. <p>Grading</p> <p>Wiki is set to be graded, a column is automatically created in the Grade Center. A graded Wiki cannot be set to ungraded. Delete the graded Wiki from the Wikis listing page and the Grade Center, and create a new ungraded Wiki. Alternatively, do not include the graded Wiki column in Grade Center calculations, if the Wiki pages need to be retained.</p>												
Step 1	On the Wiki topic page , click Participation and Grading .

- Step 5
- Type a numeric grade in the Current Grade Value text box.
 - **Feedback:** Add feedback for the student.
 - **Grading Notes:** Appear to the Instructor and Grader only.
 - Optionally, use the Spell Check function in the bottom of each text box. Click Text Editor to access all the Text Editor functions for formatting text and adding URLs, attachments, images, Mashups, and multimedia.
 - Click **Save Grade**.
 - Click **OK** to return to wiki page.



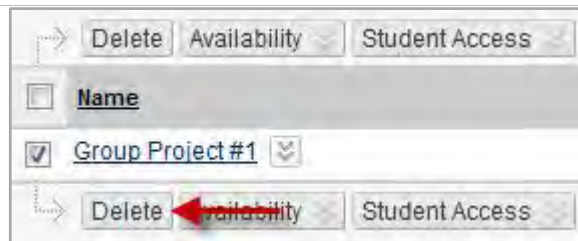
Deleting

If a gradable Wiki is no longer needed, it can be deleted. It is permanently deleted and the action cannot be undone.

- Step 1
- Click on the **content area** by clicking on it in the course menu
 - Click on **Wikis**.

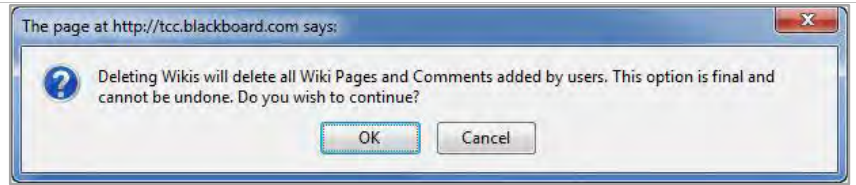


- Step 2
- Click the **checkbox** next to the wiki title.
 - Click **Delete**.



Step 3

- Before deleting, a **graded wiki** will prompt for confirmation.
- Confirm by clicking **OK** or **Cancel**.
- If grade columns exist in the Grade Center for the Group, the columns can be retained. On the Delete Confirmation page, do not select the check boxes for any columns that need to be preserved.



Reminder: Deleting is permanent and the action cannot be undone.
