




## Test question types

Question Type	Description
Create a fill in the blank question	A statement that requires an answer to complete it. Answers are evaluated based on an exact text match. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a short answer question	Similar to Essay questions; answer length is limited. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a matching question	Two columns of items where each item in the first column must be matched to an item in the second column. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a true or false question	A statement with the option to choose either true or false. True/False answer options are limited to the words True and False. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a calculated formula question	Contains a formula with a number of variables. The correct answer can be a specific value or a range of values. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a calculated numeric question	Resembles a fill-in-the-blank question except a number is entered to complete the statement. The correct answer can be a specific number or within a range of numbers. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create an essay question	A question where the answer must be typed in a text box. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a fill in multiple blanks question	Multiple responses are inserted into a sentence or paragraph. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a hot spot question	A specific point on an image is used to indicate the answer. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a jumbled question	A sentence with a number of variables within it. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a Likert question	A rating scale used to measure attitudes or reactions. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )

Create a multiple answer question	A number of choices with one or more correct answers. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a multiple choice question	Allows a number of choices with one correct answer. Indicate the correct answer by selecting a radio button. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create an ordering question	A question that requires users to provide an answer by selecting the correct order of a series of items. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a quiz bowl question	An answer appears; the users respond with a who, what, or where question to respond. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Create a random block and adding to a test	Random Blocks are groups of questions that can be presented in a random fashion determined by the Instructor. Random Blocks are created by finding and selecting questions, deciding on the number of points per question, and then determining the number of questions to display to the user. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a>   <a href="#">Video</a> )
Either/or	A statement with a pre-defined choice of two answers (Yes/No, On/Off). ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a> )
File response	Uploaded files are used to respond to the question. ( <a href="#">Tutorial</a> )
