MUSTANGS (3-4, 0-0 AAC)



North Texas is off to its best start since the 2011-12 season when they also began the year 4-1. The Mean Green are riding a two-game winning streak after they defeated Coastal Carolina and Detroit Mercy in the San Juan Shootout.

UNT has been led by preseason all-conference player Terriell Bradley. She is averaging 16.6 points per game. She scored a total of 42 points in the Mean Green's two games combined at the San Juan Shootout. Against Coastal Carolina, North Texas held the Chanticleers to just 34 points, which was tied for the second fewest points allowed in program history. The Mean Green enter Wednesday's match-up as the No. 3 scoring defense in the country and are holding opponents to just a 30.7 FG percentage, which is the second-best in the country.

North Texas' Top Storylines, Streaks & Trends

RECORD-SETTING DEBUT

Freshman Lauren Holmes scored 20 points and had 12 rebounds in her college debut in the Mean Green's season-opener on Nov. 10. It's the most points scored in school history by a true freshman in their debut. It's also the most points scored in a Mean Green debut since Jill Medlock (a then junior transfer from Arkansas-Fort Smith) scored 20 points against Indiana State on Nov. 22, 2003.

Holmes is also the first true freshman to record a double-double in program history since Alexis Hyder in 2012.

Holmes scored 19 points on Friday vs. Detroit Mercy.

LOOKING FOR WIN NO. 5

Since 1981, UNT has only won five games before the month of December once. It happened in 2007 when they went 5-3 in November.

With its six-point win over Detroit Mercy on Friday, UNT won its fourth non-conference game of the year, which is one more than they won all of last year. A fifth non-conference win

would tie the 2015-16 season, which was head coach Jalie Mitchell's first season.

The last time they won six non-conference games was in 2013-14 when they went 6-7 in non-conference play.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Mean Green played their first three games of the year at home at the Super Pit and will play seven of their 12 non-conference games there too. North Texas plays a total of 16 home games this year. Both are the most under third-year head coach Jalie Mitchell. Last year North Texas played just four home non-conference games and 13 total home games.

SLAYING THE POWER-5

In each of Jalie Mitchell's first two seasons at North Texas the Mean Green have beaten a power-5 school on the road — Oklahoma in 2015 and Arizona in 2016. North Texas lost 55-54 to Kansas State on Nov. 19 and they travel to Indiana on Dec. 5.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was voted by the C-USA coaches to the eight-player preseason all-conference team. She is the first North Texas women's basketball player to earn a preseason all-conference nod since 2011 when the Mean Green played in the Sun Belt.

Bradley is averaging 15.3 point per game through the first four games of the year. She averaged 13 a year ago.

Friday versus Detroit Mercy, Bradley scored a season high 22 points. It was her third game this year with 18 or more points. Last season she had 10 games of 18 or more points.

OH CAY!

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner came out of her shell in the Mean Green's win over Texas A&M International. Buckner finished with a career-high 20 points and was one rebound away from her first career double-double. She also tied a then career-high with three blocks in the game.

The 20-point performance bested her previous high of 12, which she set on Nov. 10 in the Mean Green's season opener.

Buckner was 9-of-11 from the field in the game against TAMIU and stayed out of foul trouble, which has hindered her in the past.

OWNING THE PAINT

North Texas has outscored its first five opponents in the paint by a combined score of 144-50.

They outscored Texas A&M International 44-2 in the paint in their second game of the year.

45.4 percent of UNT's points this season have come from inside the paint.

STEALS

North Texas is averaging 10.8 steals per game through the first five games. That's 3.4 more steals per game than they averaged last season.

The Mean Green finished the 2016-17 season

with 232 steals. They have 54 through the first five games of this season.

Freshman Lauren Holmes and redshirt junior Terriell Bradley have recorded at least one steal in all five games this season. Bradley's game-high for steals this season is three while Holmes' is four. They are responsible for 22 of the Mean Green's 54 steals this season.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Freshman Lauren Holmes has scored 57 points and recorded 34 rebounds through her first five games.

In comparison, last season's four freshmen combined had only scored 38 points and grabbed 24 rebounds through the first five games of the year.

Also in comparison, in 2013 when 2017 UNT graduate Candice Adams, the Mean Green's only top-100 high school recruit, was a freshman she had only scored 21 points and had eight rebounds in her first five games.

Since 1998, only Alexis Hyder and Jalie Mitchell have scored more points through their first five games than Holmes. Both Mitchell and Hyder were named all-conference their freshmen seasons.

SAN JUAN SHOOTOUT

The Mean Green were schedule to play in the San Juan Shootout in San Juan Puerto Rico over the Thanksgiving Weekend. However, due to Hurricane Maria the tournament was moved to Daytona Beach, Florida. North Texas defeated both Coastal Carolina and Detroit Mercy in its two games at the shootout.

It would have been the first time in program history the Mean Green had played outside the continental United States.

NEW ADDITION

In May, the Mean Green added veteran WNBA coach Carlos Knox to their coaching staff.

NEW POSITION

In August, the Mean Green added their first-ever full-time strength and conditioning coach in Rick Lefebvre who spent the last five seasons as LSU's men's basketball strength and conditioning coach.

AD's NEW POSITION

Sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved from point guard to guard in hope of freeing her up as a scorer. Henderson scored over 1,200 points in high school and averaged over 20 points per game.

As a freshman at UNT, Henderson saw limited playing time early but as the season progressed so did her playing time.

Henderson scored a season-high nine points versus Detroit Mercy on Nov. 24.

ATHLETIC FAMILY

Freshman Deja Terrell is the daughter of former NFL player David Terrell and her mother, Kiana Taylor-Terrell is one of the greatest UTEP women's basketball players in program history. When she graduated in 1998, she was second in program history in scoring (1,134) and second in rebounds (676). Deja Terrell was also a two-time all-district volleyball player at Life Oak Cliff High School in Dallas.

EARLY SIGNEES

North Texas signed two Texas products in the early signing period. The Mean Green have added Jasmyne Robinson of Arlington Bowie High School and Charlene Shepherd of Shoemaker High School in Killeen, Texas.

Robinson is a 5-foot-8 guard who is a tremendous shooter. She recently scored her 1,000th career point and was named as the district MVP her sophomore season.

Shepherd is a forward who can stretch the court as a shooter. She's been named all-district in both basketball and volleyball.

ARKANSAS' GEM

North Texas freshman Lauren Holmes was named the 2017 Arkansas Prep Female Athlete of the Year after she graduated from Fayetteville High School.

A three-sport athlete, Holmes graduated from FHS with nine state titles in the three sports combined. She won two basketball championships, two team track and field championships and one volleyball championship. She also won four individual track and field championships. She accomplished all of it in just three years.

In addition to her on the field success, Holmes graduated high school with a 3.9 G.P.A. and worked two separate jobs all at the same time.

OVERCOMING HER DISABILITY

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was born with scoliosis. It hasn't affected her much on the court with exception of one game in 2016 when she could barely walk the night before.

Despite struggling to walk, Bradley went on to score 17 points in the game at Arizona and led the team to the road victory.

NEW PGs

The point guard position is very important to head coach Jalie Mitchell. She begins the 2017-18 season with two new point guards in freshman Trena Mims and JC transfer Brittany Smith. Last year's point guards, Kelsey Criner graduated and now-sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved to off the ball guard but can take the ball up the court to initiate the offense.

BRITT-NASTY

North Texas has added South Plains College transfer point guard Brittany Smith to their roster. Smith was the 2017 Western Junior College Conference Defensive Player of the Year and a WJCC First-Team All-Conference. She made the Mean Green's first points of the season with a 3-pointer.

OVERTIME WARRIORS

The Mean Green are riding a four-game overtime winning streak. All four of those overtime wins came last season in conference games away from the Super Pit.

North Texas only had three overtime wins away from the Super Pit in the program's 39-year history prior to last year.

North Texas is 10-26 all-time in overtime games. Four of those 10 wins came last year.

ESTABLISHED REBOUNDER

Sophomore Jada Poland has 25 rebounds through five games (5 per game) this season.

Last season, she didn't have 20 rebounds until the 22nd game of the year, which was on February 9th.

Poland had a season-high eight rebounds versus K-State on Nov. 19.

CLIMBING THE LADDER

After the team's third win of the year, head coach Jalie Mitchell moved into sixth-place for all-time wins in program history. She passed Shanice Stephens who Mitchell was an assistant under her first season as a coach.

OFFENSIVE FIRE

North Texas scored 86 points versus MACU, which is the most points UNT has scored in a non-overtime game since Dec. 17, 2013 when they scored 93 in a win at Denver. They scored 97 in a 3OT loss at Rice on Jan. 10, 2016.

QUICK START

North Texas scored 28 points in the first quarter of their season-opener versus MACU. It's the most points the Mean Green have scored in a first quarter ever. NCAA women's basketball switched to quarters in the 2015-16 season, which was also Mitchell's first season as the Mean Green head coach.

SEASON-ENDING INJURIES

This summer North Texas lost forward Madison Townley to a season-ending

shoulder injury, guard Tyara Warren and posts Tosin Mabodu and Hannah Hopkins to season-ending knee injuries. Both Mabodu and Warren's injuries are also career ending.

Warren was a starter last season who scored over 14 points six times and was key defender.

Mabodu started 11 games last season.

Townley was expected to compete for the starting forward position after she averaged 2.3 points and four rebounds per game while only playing an average of 16 minutes per game. She made two starts last season as a freshman.

FIVE GAME WINNING STREAK

Last season North Texas won five consecutive games from Feb. 4 to Feb. 18. It was the longest winning streak in program-history since 2012-13. The Mean Green haven't won six games in a row since 2002.

During the five game winning streak, North Texas won three consecutive road games, which is the longest road winning streak since 2002.

GOALS

Every season North Texas has the goals of winning 20+ games and winning a conference championship. North Texas hasn't won 20 games in a season since 2001-02 when they won 21 games.

#P.R.I.D.E.

North Texas women's basketball has the program acronym of P.R.I.D.E. It was created by Jalie Mitchell to emphasis the characteristics that make a strong student-athlete at the University of North Texas.

1 THROUGH 4

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley played the 1-4 positions last year and is expected to do the same this year.

GETTING IN SHAPE

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner lost considerable weight this offseason and has made it a point of emphasis to run the court better, shoot the ball and be an all-conference player. The 6-4 post began her 2017-18 campaign with a career-high 12 points on 6-8 shooting. Her previous high

was 10 points, which she accomplished twice last season.

She then scored 20 points versus Texas A&M International in UNT's second game of the year.

400-POINT CLUB

With 18 points in the Mean Green season-opener, Terriell Bradley entered the 400-point club for North Texas. Four games later the Kansas transfer has 481 points at UNT and 685 career points when you include her one season at KU.

BLOCKS

North Texas is averaging 4.4 blocks per game through the first five games of the year.

They ended last season averaging 2.1 blocks per game.

Redshirt junior Micayla Buckner leads this year's team with nine blocks on the season. She only had 13 all of last year. Furthermore, her nine blocks are already more than half as many as Hannah Hopkins had last year who led the team with 16.

Buckner had a career-best four blocks in the Mean Green's game against K-State.

Freshman Deja Terrell is second on the team with five blocks.

REBOUNDS

North Texas is averaging 39 rebounds per game through its first five games and limiting opponents to 37 rebounds per game.

In comparison, last season the Mean Green were only averaging 32.6 rebounds per game and allowing the opponent to average 40.8 rebounds per game through the first five games.

Micayla Buckner leads this year's team with 7.0 rebounds per game. Freshman Lauren Holmes isn't far behind with 6.8 rebounds per game.

THANKSGIVING DAY

UNT played Coastal Carolina on Thanksgiving day and won 50-34.

The last time and only other time North Texas played on Thanksgiving day was in 1979. North Texas lost to Cameron 75-67 on Thanksgiving Day 1979.

The Mean Green's first season was the 1976-77 season.

FRESHMEN WITH A BIGGER ROLE

North Texas freshmen Lauren Holmes and Trena Mims have scored 57 and 36 total points each, respectively. Last season, Adrianna Henderson led all Mean Green freshmen in scoring with 68 total points. Mims is halfway to 68 and Holmes is more than halfway.

20-20

Terriell Bradley scored 20 points on Nov. 23 versus Coastal Carolina and 22 points on Nov. 24 versus Detroit Mercy.

The 22-point performance tied a career-best for Bradley and it was the first time in her career (both at UNT and KU) that she had 20+ scoring outings in consecutive games.

The most points she had scored in consecutive games previously was 37 when she scored 19 versus FIU on Feb. 11, 2017 and then 18 at UTEP on Feb. 16, 2017.

Bradley first scored 22 points last season at SMU.

The last UNT women's basketball player to score at least 20 points in consecutive games was BreAnna Dawkins ('15) who scored 24 versus FAU on Feb. 19, 2015 and then 21 points versus FIU on Feb. 21, 2015.

The last Mean Green women's basketball player to score at least 20 points in three straight games was Loryn Goodwin in 2013.

Goodwin scored 26 points versus FIU on Feb. 9, 2013, 28 points at ULM on Feb. 14, 2013 and then 20 points at Troy on Feb. 16, 2013.

DEFENSIVE MINDSET

Head coach Jalie Mitchell emphasis defense over everything else.

Through five games, UNT is No. 3 in the nation in scoring defense, giving up an average of 47.2 points per game thus far.

Additionally, UNT opponents are only shooting 30.8 percent against the Mean Green, which is the second-lowest in the country. Only Green Bay's 30.5 is better than North Texas.

Forcing turnovers has been key for the Mean Green in their first five games. They have a turnover margin of +8.0, which is the 13th best in the country.

TOP FRESHMAN

Through five games Lauren Holmes leads all C-USA freshmen in rebounds per game (6.8), offensive rebounds per game (3.0) and steals per game (2.6).

She is also second in scoring per game (11.4) and 3FG per game (1.8).

GRACE GOODHART

Junior Grace Goodhart has started all five games for the Mean Green this season after only starting one game all of last year.

Through the first five games, Goodhart is averaging 7.2 points, 2.2 rebounds, 2 assists and 1.8 steals per game.

On Nov. 23rd, Goodhart set a UNT career-best by scoring 10 points. She also recorded five steals, had three assists and no turnovers in the Mean Green's win over Coastal Carolina.

SMITH'S RETURN

After missing two games due to a death in her family, junior point guard Brittany Smith returned to the Mean Green on Nov. 23rd.

Smith had started North Texas' season-opener but hasn't since returning.

In her two games back, Smith has averaged 3 points per game and 5 assists per game. Though her scoring has been down, the Mean Green offense is noticeably more efficient with her veteran leadership.

The Mean Green are averaging five more points per game in the contest Smith plays in.

THEFT

Freshman Lauren Holmes and redshirt junior Terriell Bradley have each recorded at least one steal in all five games this season for the Mean Green.

Holmes leads the team with 13 steals while Bradley is tied with Grace Goodhart for second on the team with nine.

North Texas has scored 97 points this season

off turnovers. That's 30.5 percent of their offense.

Against Coastal Carolina, UNT scored 36 of its 50 points off turnovers.

7 MIN SHUTOUT

North Texas held Coastal Carolina scoreless for the first seven minutes and 40 seconds of their game on Nov. 23rd.

29 TURNOVERS

UNT forced 29 turnovers against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 23rd. It is the most turnovers the Mean Green have forced since Nov. 24, 2012 when they forced 31 turnovers against St. Bonaventure in a 2OT win.

FREE THROWS

North Texas shot just 56 percent from the free throw line in the first four games of the season (25-44).

In their fifth game, UNT was 19-24 (79.2 percent) from the free throw line.

Terriell Bradley was 11-of-12 at the free throw line in that game. Three players were also perfect at the free throw line that day.

Through five games, UNT is being outscored by 18 points (62-44) at the free throw line.

Freshman Lauren Holmes is 6-6 at the line this season. She is the only Mean Green player yet to miss a free throw. Orianna Shillow has yet to attempt one.

Last year, senior point guard Kelsey Criner set the program record for most consecutive made free throws with 18.



Jalie Mitchell

Head Coach

Third Year
(North Texas '02)

Jalie Mitchell begins her third season as head coach of the North Texas women's basketball team.

The Mean Green have seen improvement in each of her first two seasons. She enters her third season with the most road wins and second-most total wins in program history by a coach with two full seasons under their belt.

In her first season in 2015-16, North Texas more than doubled its win total from the previous season and beat the No. 17 ranked Oklahoma Sooners in Oklahoma for their first win of the year. It was the first time a Mean Green team had beaten a ranked opponent in program history.

They proceeded to post a 11-19 record and win five regular season conference games and reach the second-round of the C-USA Championship.

In 2016-17, the Mean Green improved on their overall record by a game and set program records and firsts. They won eight Conference-USA games, the most since joining the conference in the 2013-14 season. They defeated UTEP in El Paso for the first time in program history and they reached the quarterfinals of the C-USA Championship for the first time as well.

North Texas' three-game road winning streak in February of 2017 was its longest road winning streak since the 2001-02 season when Mitchell was a senior at North Texas and its overall five game winning streak in February was the longest since the 2012-13 season..

When hired, Mitchell described North Texas as her dream job. The 2002 Mean Green graduate is the program's greatest player and boasts numerous records as a four-year letter winner. She is the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two women's basketball numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Athletic Hall of Fame.

Under Mitchell, North Texas has had a noticeable increase in offense and defense. In her first season, the Mean Green improved their field goal percentage by 7.23 percent — the largest improvement in the country. It was also the sixth-highest shooting percentage in North Texas history. In total, the Mean Green averaged nearly 10 more points per game in 2015-16 than the year before. In 2016-17, North Texas held conference opponents to 62.9 points per game and typically held the opposition's leading scorer to 10 or more points below their season average.

Prior to becoming the Mean Green's head coach, Mitchell had two stints as an assistant in Denton. Most recently under then head coach Karen Aston for the 2011-12 campaign. In that campaign, the team went 15-16.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the University of Texas in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC-Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

In addition to the North Texas Athletics Hall of Fame, Mitchell was inducted into the Duncanville ISD Athletic Hall of Honor in October of 2015.



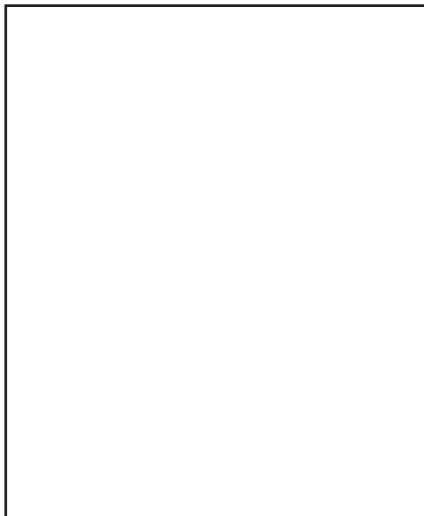
