

North Texas is off to its best start since the 2005-06 season when they also began the year 5-1. The 2005-06 team was the last Mean Green women's basketball team to finish a season with a winning record (19-9). That UNT team finished non-conference 10-2.

UNT is currently riding a three-game winning streak, It is only the third time in five years the Mean Green have won three or more consecutive games.

The Mean Green have gotten off to the hot start thanks to a tremendous defense that ranks in the top-5 in the nation. UNT opponents are only averaging 46 points per game on 30.5 percent shooting.

North Texas' Top Storylines, Streaks & Trends

### **D-FENSE**

-As of Nov. 30, North Texas' defense ranks No. 3 in the nation. The Mean Green defense is giving up an average of just 46 points per game through their first six games.

-Last season at this point during the year UNT's opponents were averaging 65 points per game.

- -On Nov. 23 they held Coastal Carolina to 34 points, which is tied for the secondfewest points allowed by the Mean Green in program history.
- -UNT has held three of its six opponents to 40 or fewer points. Under Jalie Mitchell the Mean Green have held five teams to 40 or fewer points. In the 1,094 games before Mitchell's arrival, UNT had just six such games.
- -The Mean Green are forcing an average of 22 turnovers per game and have a +8.7 turnover margin that ranks as the 13th best in the country.

### **BEST START IN 12 YEARS**

- -North Texas last started a season 6-1 in 2005-06 when they began the year 7-1.
- Six non-conference wins would be a new program record under Jalie Mitchell.
- -The last time they won six nonconference games was in 2013-14 when they went 6-7 in non-conference play.

### **LAST GAME RECAP**

THE GOOD

The Mean Green contained SMU to 26 points below their season average and held the Mustangs' leading scorer McKenzie Adams to 15 points on 16 shot attempts. She entered the game averaging 22 points per game.

#### THE OK

Despite shooting 32 percent from the field, North Texas never trailed against SMU thanks to a 7-0 to start the game.

#### THE BAD

UNT was 4-for-21 from beyond the arc. THE UGLY

The Mean Green were out rebounded 43-

### **HOME SWEET HOME**

The Mean Green have played four of their first six games of the year at home at the Super Pit and will play seven of their 12 non-conference games there too. North Texas plays a total of 16 home games this year. Both are the most under third-year head coach Jalie Mitchell. Last year North Texas played just four home non-conference games and 13 total home games.

#### **SLAYING THE POWER-5**

In each of Jalie Mitchell's first two seasons at North Texas the Mean Green have beaten a power-5 school on the road — No. 15 Oklahoma in 2015 and Arizona in 2016. North Texas lost 55-54 to Kansas State on Nov. 19 and they travel to Indiana on Dec. 5.

### PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was voted by the C-USA coaches to the eight-player preseason all-conference team. She is the first North Texas women's basketball player to earn a preseason all-conference nod since 2011 when the Mean Green played in the Sun Belt.

Bradley is averaging 15.7 point per game through the first six games of the year. She averaged 13 a year ago.

Wednesday versus SMU, Bradley was contained early on but finished the game with 11 points, earning five at the free throw line.

### OH CAY!

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner had her first career double-double on Wednesday versus SMU when she scored 10 points and had 11 rebounds.

Buckner came out of her shell in the Mean Green's win over Texas A&M International. Buckner finished with a career-high 20 points and was one rebound away from a double-double. She also tied a then career-high with three blocks in the game. She has since set a new career-high in blocks with four.

The 20-point performance bested her previous high of 12, which she set on Nov. 10 in the Mean Green's season opener.

Buckner was 9-of-11 from the field in the game against TAMIU and stayed out of foul trouble, which has hindered her in the past.

#### **STEALS**

North Texas is averaging just under 10 steals per game through the first six games. That's 3 more steals per game than they averaged last season.

The Mean Green finished the 2016-17 season with 232 steals. They have 59 through the first six games of this season.

Freshman Lauren Holmes and redshirt junior Terriell Bradley have recorded at least one steal in all six games this season. Bradley's game-high for steals this season is three while Holmes' is four. They are responsible for 24 of the Mean Green's 59 steals this season.

### **29 TURNOVERS**

UNT forced 29 turnovers against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 23rd. It is the most turnovers the Mean Green have forced since Nov. 24, 2012 when they forced 31 turnovers against St. Bonaventure in a 2OT win.

#### **RECORD-SETTING DEBUT**

Freshman Lauren Holmes scored 20 points and had 12 rebounds in her college debut in the Mean Green's season-opener on Nov. 10. It's the most points scored in school history by a true freshman in their debut. It's also the most points scored in a Mean Green debut since Jill Medlock (a then junior transfer from Arkansas-Fort Smith) scored 20 points against Indiana State on Nov. 22, 2003.

Holmes is also the first true freshman to record a double-double in program history since Alexis Hyder in 2012.

### **NEW ADDITION**

In May, the Mean Green added veteran WNBA coach Carlos Knox to their coaching staff. Knox won a WNBA Championship with the Indiana Fever in 2012.

### **500 POINTS**

Terriell Bradley is just eight points away from scoring her 500th career point at UNT.

### **700 POINTS**

Terriell Bradley is just four points away from scoring her 700th career point when you include her freshman season at KU.

### IN THE END

North Texas has played 24 quarters this season. They have trailed at the end of only one of the 24 quarters (fourth quarter versus

K-State).

They were tied at the end of the first quarter with Detroit Mercy on Nov. 24.

### **NEW POSITION**

In August, the Mean Green added their firstever full-time strength and conditioning coach in Rick Lefebvre who spent the last five seasons as LSU's men's basketball strength and conditioning coach.

#### **AD's NEW POSITION**

Sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved from point guard to guard in hope of freeing her up as a scorer. Henderson scored over 1,200 points in high school and averaged over 20 points per game.

As a freshman at UNT, Henderson saw limited playing time early but as the season progressed so did her playing time.

Henderson scored a season-high nine points versus Detroit Mercy on Nov. 24. Her careerhigh is 10, which she accomplished versus Iona last season.

### **ATHLETIC FAMILY**

Freshman Deja Terrell is the daughter of former NFL veteran David Terrell and her mother, Kiana Taylor-Terrell is one of the greatest UTEP women's basketball players in program history. When she graduated in 1998 she was second in program history in scoring (1,134) and second in rebounds (676). Deja Terrell was also a two-time all-district volleyball player at Life Oak Cliff High School in Dallas.

#### **EARLY SIGNEES**

North Texas signed two Texas products in the early signing period. The Mean Green have added Jasmyne Robinson of Arlington Bowie High School and Charlene Shepherd of Shoemaker High School in Killeen, Texas.

Robinson is a 5-foot-8 guard who is a tremendous shooter. She recently scored her 1,000th career point and was named as the district MVP her sophomore season.

Shepherd is a forward who can stretch the court as a shooter. She's been named all-district in both basketball and volleyball.

### **FORGED BY FAYETTEVILLE**

North Texas freshman Lauren Holmes was named the 2017 Arkansas Prep Female Athlete of the Year after she graduated from Fayetteville High School.

A three-sport athlete, Holmes graduated from FHS with nine state titles in the three sports combined. She won two basketball championships, two team track and field championships and one volleyball championship. She also won four individual track and field championships. She accomplished all of it in just three years.

In addition to her on the field success, Holmes graduated high school with a 3.9 G.P.A. and worked two separate jobs all at the same time.

### **OVERCOMING HER DISABILITY**

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was born with scoliosis. It hasn't affected her much on the court with exception of one game in 2016 when she could barely walk the night before.

Despite struggling to walk, Bradley went on to score 17 points in the game at Arizona and led the team to the road victory.

### **NEW PGs**

The point guard position is very important to head coach Jalie Mitchell. She begins the 2017-18 season with two new point guards in freshman Trena Mims and JC transfer Brittany Smith. Last year's point guards, Kelsey Criner graduated and now-sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved to off the ball guard but can take the ball up the court to initiate the offense.

### **BRITT-NASTY**

North Texas has added South Plains College transfer point guard Brittany Smith to their roster. Smith was the 2017 Western Junior

College Conference Defensive Player of the Year and WJCC First-Team All-Conference. She made the Mean Green's first points of the season with a 3-pointer.

#### **OVERTIME WARRIORS**

The Mean Green are riding a four-game overtime winning streak. All four of those overtime wins came last season in conference games away from the Super Pit.

North Texas only had three overtime wins away from the Super Pit in the program's 39year history prior to last year.

North Texas is 10-26 all-time in overtime games. Four of those 10 wins came last year.

#### **ESTABLISHED REBOUNDER**

Sophomore Jada Poland has 28 rebounds through five games (4.7 per game) this season.

Last season, she didn't have 20 rebounds until the 22nd game of the year, which was on February 9th.

Poland had a season-high eight rebounds versus K-State on Nov. 19.

#### **CLIMBING THE LADDER**

After Wednesday's win over SMU, head coach Jalie Mitchell moved into a tie for fifth-place for all-time wins in program history.

### **OFFENSIVE FIRE**

North Texas scored 86 points versus MACU, which is the most points UNT has scored in a non-overtime game since Dec. 17, 2013 when they scored 93 in a win at Denver. They scored 97 in a 3OT loss at Rice on Jan. 10, 2016.

### **QUICK START**

North Texas scored 28 points in the first quarter of their season-opener versus MACU. It's the most points the Mean Green have scored in a first quarter ever. NCAA women's basketball switched to quarters in the 2015-16 season, which was also Mitchell's first season as the Mean Green head coach.

### **SEASON-ENDING INJURIES**

This summer North Texas lost forward Madison Townley to a season-ending shoulder injury, guard Tyara Warren and posts Tosin Mabodu and Hannah Hopkins to season-ending knee injuries. Both Mabodu and Warren's injuries are also career ending.

Warren was a starter last season who scored over 14 points six times and was key defender.

Mabodu started 11 games last season.

Townley was expected to compete for the starting forward position after she averaged 2.3 points and four rebounds per game while only playing an average of 16 minutes per game. She made two starts last season as a freshman.

### FIVE GAME WINNING STREAK

Last season North Texas won five consecutive games from Feb. 4 to Feb. 18. It was the longest winning streak in program-history since 2012-13. The Mean Green haven't won six games in a row since 2002.

During the five game winning streak, North Texas won three consecutive road games, which is the longest road winning streak since 2002.

### **GOALS**

Every season North Texas has the goals of winning 20+ games and winning a conference championship. North Texas hasn't won 20 games in a season since 2001-02 when they won 21 games.

### #P.R.I.D.E.

North Texas women's basketball has the program acronym of P.R.I.D.E. It was created by Jalie Mitchell to emphasis the characteristics that make a strong student-athlete at the University of North Texas.

### 1 THROUGH 4

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley played the 1-4 positions last year and still does that this year.

### **GETTING IN SHAPE**

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner lost considerable weight this offseason and has made it a point of emphasis to run the court better, shoot the ball and be an all-conference player. The 6-4 post began her 2017-18 campaign with a career-high 12 points on 6-8 shooting. Her previous high was 10 points, which she accomplished twice last season.

She then scored 20 points versus Texas A&M International in UNT's second game of the year.

She then recorded her first career double-double in their sixth game of the year.

### **NOVEMBER TO REMEMBER**

North Texas won five games before the month of December for only the second time in program history since 1981.

The most games the Mean Green have won before the month of January is 10, which they accomplished in 2005-06 when they started the season 10-2.

### **BLOCKS**

North Texas is averaging 4 blocks per game through the first six games of the year.

They ended last season averaging 2.1 blocks per game.

Redshirt junior Micayla Buckner leads this year's team with nine blocks on the season. She only had 13 all of last year. Furthermore, her nine blocks are already more than half as many as Hannah Hopkins had last year who led the team with 16.

Buckner had a career-best four blocks in the Mean Green's game against K-State.

Freshman Deja Terrell is second on the team with five blocks.

### 15-15

Guard Terriell Bradley has made 15 consecutive free throws. The program record is 18 set by 2017 grad Kelsey Criner who ended her career by making 18 straight.

Bradley missed her first free throw attempt on Nov. 24 versus Detroit Mercy but proceeded to make her next 10 attempts in the game. Then on Wednesday, Bradley was a perfect 5-5 from the free throw line.

### FRESHMEN WITH A BIGGER ROLE

North Texas freshmen Lauren Holmes and Trena Mims have scored this season 60 and 40 points, respectively. Last season, Adrianna Henderson led all Mean Green freshmen in scoring at the end of the year with 67 total points.

Holmes, Mims and fellow freshman Deja Terrell are a combined 43 points away from outscoring last year's four freshmen combined total from.

### 20-20

Terriell Bradley scored 20 points on Nov. 23 versus Coastal Carolina and 22 points on Nov. 24 versus Detroit Mercy.

The 22-point performance tied a career-best for Bradley and it was the first time in her career (both at UNT and KU) that she had 20+ scoring outings in consecutive games.

The most points she had scored in consecutive games previously was 37 when she scored 19 versus FIU on Feb. 11, 2017 and then 18 at UTEP on Feb. 16, 2017.

Her streak ended versus SMU when she was held to just 11 points.

### **DEFENSIVE MINDSET**

Head coach Jalie Mitchell emphasis defense over everything else.

Through six games, UNT has the nation's No. 1 field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to an average field goal percentage of 30.5%.

North Texas also has the No. 3 scoring defense, giving up just an average of 46 points per game thus far.

Forcing turnovers has been key for the Mean Green in their first six games. They have a turnover margin of +8.6, which is the 13th best in the country.

### **TOP FRESHMAN**

Through the first fives games Lauren Holmes leads all C-USA freshmen in rebounds per game (6.8), offensive rebounds per game (3.0) and steals per game (2.6).

She is also was second in scoring per game (11.4) and 3FG per game (1.8).

### **GRACE GOODHART**

Junior Grace Goodhart started the first five games of the year for the Mean Green this season after only starting one game all of last year. Goodhart didn't start Wednesday's game versus SMU due to a injury sustained in their game versus Detroit Mercy, but she still played 10 minutes versus the Mustangs..

On Nov. 23rd, Goodhart set a UNT careerbest by scoring 10 points. She also recorded five steals, had three assists and no turnovers in the Mean Green's win over Coastal Carolina.

### **SMITH'S RETURN**

After missing two games due to a death in her family, junior point guard Brittany Smith returned to the Mean Green on Nov. 23rd.

Smith started North Texas' season-opener but came off the bench in her first two games back.

She returned to the starting lineup on Wednesday versus SMU and finished with a UNT career-high nine points .

#### THEFT

Freshman Lauren Holmes and redshirt junior Terriell Bradley have each recorded at least one steal in all six games this season for the Mean Green.

Holmes leads the team with 14 steals while Bradley is in second with 10.

North Texas has scored 114 points this season off turnovers. That's 31.3 percent of its offense.

Against Coastal Carolina, UNT scored 36 of its 50 total points off turnovers.

### **7 MIN SHUTOUT**

North Texas held Coastal Carolina scoreless for the first seven minutes and 40 seconds of their game on Nov. 23rd.

### **FREE THROWS**

North Texas shot just 56 percent from the free throw line in the first four games of the season (25-44).

They flipped the script in their fifth game, when they went 19-24 (79.2 percent) from the free throw line.

However, against SMU on Wednesday they went back to their poor free throw shooting ways by making just 7-of-12 (58.3 percent)

Through six games, UNT is being outscored by 24 points (75-51) at the free throw line.

Freshman Lauren Holmes is 6-6 at the line this season. She is the only Mean Green player yet to miss a free throw. Orianna Shillow has yet to attempt one.

#### **OWNING THE PAINT**

North Texas has outscored its first six opponents in the paint by a combined score of 160-66.

They outscored Texas A&M International 44-2 in the paint in their second game of the year.

44 percent of UNT's points this season have come from inside the paint.

### **HUSTLE STATS**

UNT takes pride in out working its opponents. Hustle stats are kept by strength and conditioning coach Rich Lefebvre. He also keeps track of the opponents hustle stats.

Hustle points are awarded for deflections, charges drawn and 50/50 balls (loose-ball recovery). One point for each stat.

Through six games, UNT has yet to have a game with fewer hustle points than its opponent.

Lauren Holmes leads the Mean Green with 26 hustle points. She has nine more hustle points than Terriell Bradley who has the second-most.

Through six games, Holmes has drawn a total of seven charges and has at least one in every game except their second game of the year versus Texas A&M International.

# Third Year (North Texas '02)

Jalie Mitchell begins her third season as head coach of the North Texas women's basketball team.

The Mean Green have seen improvement in each of her first two seasons. She enters her third season with the most road wins and second-most total wins in program history by a coach with two full seasons under their belt.

In her first season in 2015-16, North Texas more than doubled its win total from the previous season and beat the No. 17 ranked Oklahoma Sooners in Oklahoma for their first win of the year. It was the first time a Mean Green team had beaten a ranked opponent in program history.

They proceeded to post a 11-19 record and win five regular season conference games and reach the second-round of the C-USA Championship.

In 2016-17, the Mean Green improved on their overall record by a game and set program records and firsts. They won eight Conference-USA games, the most since joining the conference in the 2013-14 season. They defeated UTEP in El Paso for the first time in program history and they reached the quarterfinals of the C-USA Championship for the first time as well.

North Texas' three-game road winning streak in February of 2017 was its longest road winning streak since the 2001-02 season when Mitchell was a senior at North Texas and its overall five game winning streak in February was the longest since the 2012-13 season..

When hired, Mitchell described North Texas as her dream job. The 2002 Mean Green graduate is the program's greatest player and boasts numerous records as a four-year letter winner. She is the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two women's basketball numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Athletic Hall of Fame.

Under Mitchell, North Texas has had a noticeable increase in offense and defense. In her first season, the Mean Green improved their field goal percentage by 7.23 percent — the largest improvement in the country. It was also the sixth-highest shooting percentage in North Texas history. In total, the Mean Green averaged nearly 10 more points per game in 2015-16 than the year before. In 2016-17, North Texas held conference opponents to 62.9 points per game and typically held the opposition's leading scorer to 10 or more points below their season average.

Prior to becoming the Mean Green's head coach, Mitchell had two stints as an assistant in Denton. Most recently under then head coach Karen Aston for the 2011-12 campaign. In that campaign, the team went 15-16.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the University of Texas in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC-Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

In addition to the North Texas Athletics Hall of Fame, Mitchell was inducted into the Duncanville ISD Athletic Hall of Honor in October of 2015.


