La Salle won the opening tip against North Texas on Dec. 9 but that was it. The Mean Green went on a 16-0 run in the first quarter to take a commanding lead and they never looked back. La Salle at one point got the deficit to single digits but in the second-half Lauren Holmes and the Mean Green blew the game open to win by 26 points, which is tied for their second-largest win of the year.

UNT was led by freshman Lauren Holmes, who led all scorers with 17 points and had a season-high five steals in the game while also not committing a turnover. Holmes made three 3-pointers and marked the Explorers' leading scorer Amy Griffin, holding her to six points below her season average of 18. Holmes' success was honored by winning last week's C-USA Freshman of the Week.

North Texas' Top Storylines, Streaks & Trends

7-2

- North Texas is off to its best nine-game start since the 2011-12 season when they also started 7-2. The 2011-12 team lost its next four games before the start of conference.

- The last time UNT started 8-2 was in 2005-06. That team began the year 12-2 and proceeded to win 19 games and claim the Sun Belt West Division. It was also the last Mean Green team to finish a season with a winning record.

RPI

- On Monday the Mean Green received a RPI ranking of 126, which is their highest RPI ranking since the final RPI poll of the 2005-06 season when they were 114,

- When head coach Jalie Mitchell and her staff took over the program on April 9, 2015, UNT had an RPI ranking of 328. The 202-point jump during that time is the largest in C-USA.

LAST GAME RECAP

THE GOOD

North Texas committed a season-low 13 fouls versus La Salle. It was the first time this year UNT had less fouls than its opponent

THE OK

North Texas forced 27 turnovers, which they scored 26 points off of and are the second-most they've forced this season.

THE BAD

Though they held La Salle to only 47 FG attempts, the Explorers made 40 percent of them including 7-of-14 in the fourth quarter.

THE UGLY

Nothing horrendous but UNT was blocked a season-high nine times by the bigger La Salle team.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Mean Green have played six of their first nine games of the year at home and will play seven of their 12 non-conference games there too. North Texas plays a total of 16 home games this year. Both are the most under third-year head coach Jalie Mitchell. Last year North Texas played just four home non-conference games and 13 total.

TRENA BENA

Over the last three games, Mean Green freshman point guard Trena Mims is second on the team in scoring. Mims is averaging 9.3 points per game while shooting 50 percent from the field.

She has also led the team in assists, averaging 3 per game, with a career-high 4 assists in each of their last two games.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was voted by the C-USA coaches to the eight-player preseason all-conference team. She is the first North Texas women's basketball player to earn a preseason all-conference nod since 2011 when the Mean Green played in the Sun Belt.

Bradley is averaging 16.3 point per game through the first nine games of the year. She averaged 13 a year ago.

Bradley has four 20 plus scoring outings this season, which is one more than she had all of last season.

OH CAY!

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner had her first career double-double versus SMU when she scored 10 points and had 11 rebounds.

Buckner came out of her shell in the Mean Green's win over Texas A&M International. Buckner finished with a career-high 20 points and was one rebound away from a double-double. She also tied a then career-high with three blocks in the game. She has since set a new career-high in blocks with four.

Buckner was 9-of-11 from the field in the game against TAMIU and stayed out of foul trouble, which has hindered her in the past.

STEALS

North Texas is averaging just under 10 steals per game through the first nine games. That's 3 more steals per game than they averaged last season.

The Mean Green finished the 2016-17 season with 232 steals. They have 89 through the first nine games of this season.

Freshman Lauren Holmes has recorded at least one steal in all eight games this season

and leads the team with 24.

Kelsey Criner led the team last year in steals with 49. Holmes is on pace to finish with 75 steals during the regular season. 74 steals would tie her for the 10th most in a single season in program history. 92 steals is the program record.

29 TURNOVERS

UNT forced 29 turnovers against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 23rd. It is the most turnovers the Mean Green have forced since Nov. 24, 2012 when they forced 31 turnovers against St. Bonaventure in a 2OT win.

Last season versus Indiana, North Texas forced 28 turnovers.

RECORD-SETTING DEBUT

Freshman Lauren Holmes scored 20 points and had 12 rebounds in her college debut in the Mean Green's season-opener on Nov. 10. It's the most points scored in school history by a true freshman in their debut. It's also the most points scored in a Mean Green debut since Jill Medlock (a then junior transfer from Arkansas-Fort Smith) scored 20 points against Indiana State on Nov. 22, 2003.

Holmes is also the first true freshman to record a double-double in program history since Alexis Hyder in 2012.

NEW ADDITION

In May, the Mean Green added veteran WNBA coach Carlos Knox to their coaching staff. Knox won a WNBA Championship with the Indiana Fever in 2012.

500 POINTS

Terriell Bradley scored her 500th career point at UNT in the second quarter versus Tulsa on Dec. 2. She enters Saturday's game with 537 career points.

700 POINTS

When you include her freshman season at KU, Terriell Bradley scored her 700th career point in the second quarter versus Tulsa on Dec. 2.

HOME WINNING STREAK

On Saturday, North Texas will be looking to win its third consecutive home game. The Mean Green haven't won three straight home games since February of 2014, making it the longest home winning streak under Jalie Mitchell if UNT wins.

CLIMBING THE LADDER

Head coach Jalie Mitchell could possibly move into third place in all-time coaching wins at North Texas before the end of this season.

Mitchell won her 30th career game versus La Salle. She is the second-fastest in program history to 30 wins (70 games). Only Cherrri Rapp, the program's first coach, did it faster (57 games).

ATHLETIC FAMILY

Freshman Deja Terrell is the daughter of former NFL veteran David Terrell who was a safety for the Washington Redskins and Oakland Raiders. Deja Terrell's mother, Kiana Taylor-Terrell is one of the greatest UTEP women's basketball players in program history. When she graduated in 1998 she was second in program history in scoring (1,134) and second in rebounds (676). Deja Terrell was also a two-time all-district volleyball player at Life Oak Cliff High School in Dallas.

FRESHMEN WITH A BIGGER ROLE

North Texas freshmen Lauren Holmes and Trena Mims have scored this season 99 and 71 points, respectively. Last season, Adrianna Henderson led all Mean Green freshmen in scoring at the end of the year with 67 total points.

Holmes and Mims are a combined five points away from outscoring all four of last season's freshmen combined season total of 174 points.

FORGED BY FAYETTEVILLE

North Texas freshman Lauren Holmes was named the 2017 Arkansas Prep Female Athlete of the Year after she graduated from Fayetteville High School.

A three-sport athlete, Holmes graduated from FHS with nine state titles in the three sports combined. She won two basketball championships, two team track and field championships and one volleyball championship. She also won four individual track and field championships. She

accomplished all of it in just three years.

In addition to her on the field success, Holmes graduated high school with a 3.9 G.P.A. and worked two separate jobs all at the same time.

OVERCOMING HER DISABILITY

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley was born with scoliosis. It hasn't affected her much on the court with exception of one game in 2016 when she could barely walk the night before.

Despite struggling to walk, Bradley went on to score 17 points in the game at Arizona and led the team to the road victory.

NEW POSITION

In August, the Mean Green added their first-ever full-time strength and conditioning coach in Rick Lefebvre who spent the last five seasons as LSU's men's basketball strength and conditioning coach.

NEW PGs

The point guard position is very important to head coach Jalie Mitchell. She begins the 2017-18 season with two new point guards in freshman Trena Mims and JC transfer Brittany Smith. Last year's point guards, Kelsey Criner graduated and now-sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved to off the ball guard but can take the ball up the court to initiate the offense.

BRITT-NASTY

North Texas has added South Plains College transfer point guard Brittany Smith to their roster. Smith was the 2017 Western Junior College Conference Defensive Player of the Year and WJCC First-Team All-Conference. She made the Mean Green's first points of the season with a 3-pointer.

OVERTIME WARRIORS

The Mean Green are riding a four-game overtime winning streak. All four of those overtime wins came last season in conference games away from the Super Pit.

North Texas only had three overtime wins away from the Super Pit in the program's 39-year history prior to last year.

North Texas is 10-26 all-time in overtime games. Four of those 10 wins came last year.

EARLY SIGNEES

North Texas signed two Texas products in the early signing period. The Mean Green have added Jasmyne Robinson of Arlington Bowie High School and Charlene Shepherd of Shoemaker High School in Killeen, Texas.

Robinson is a 5-foot-8 guard who is a tremendous shooter. She recently scored her 1,000th career point and was named as the district MVP her sophomore season. Shepherd is a forward who can stretch the court as a shooter. She's been named all-district in both basketball and volleyball.

ESTABLISHED REBOUNDER

Sophomore Jada Poland has 39 rebounds through nine games (4.3 per game) this season while only playing 15 minutes per game.

Last season, she didn't have 20 rebounds until the 22nd game of the year, which was on February 9th.

Poland had a season-high eight rebounds versus K-State on Nov. 19.

She finished last season with 54 rebounds, averaging 2.7 per game.

AD'S NEW POSITION

Sophomore Adrianna Henderson has moved from point guard to guard in hope of freeing her up as a scorer. Henderson scored over 1,200 points in high school and averaged over 20 points per game.

As a freshman at UNT, Henderson saw limited playing time early but as the season progressed so did her playing time.

Henderson scored a season-high nine points versus Detroit Mercy on Nov. 24. Her career-high is 10, which she accomplished versus Iona last season.

OFFENSIVE FIRE

North Texas scored 86 points versus MACU, which is the most points UNT has scored in a non-overtime game since Dec. 17, 2013 when they scored 93 in a win at Denver. They scored 97 in a 3OT loss at Rice on Jan. 10, 2016.

QUICK START

North Texas scored 28 points in the first quarter of their season-opener versus MACU. It's the most points the Mean Green have scored in a first quarter ever. NCAA women's basketball switched to quarters in the 2015-16 season, which was also Mitchell's first season as the Mean Green head coach.

The Mean Green scored 20 points in the first quarter versus La Salle.

SEASON-ENDING INJURIES

This summer North Texas lost forward Madison Townley to a season-ending shoulder injury, guard Tyara Warren and posts Tosin Mabodu and Hannah Hopkins to season-ending knee injuries. Both Mabodu and Warren's injuries are also career ending.

Warren was a starter last season who scored over 14 points six times and was key defender.

Mabodu started 11 games last season.

Townley was expected to compete for the starting forward position after she made two starts last season as a freshman.

FIVE GAME WINNING STREAK

Last season North Texas won five consecutive games from Feb. 4 to Feb. 18. It was the longest winning streak in program-history since 2012-13. The Mean Green haven't won six games in a row since 2002.

During the five game winning streak, North Texas won three consecutive road games, which is the longest road winning streak since 2002.

GOALS

Every season North Texas has the goals of winning 20+ games and winning a conference championship. North Texas hasn't won 20 games in a season since 2001-02 when they won 21 games.

#P.R.I.D.E.

North Texas women's basketball has the program acronym of P.R.I.D.E. It was created by Jalie Mitchell to emphasis the

1 THROUGH 4

Mean Green redshirt junior Terriell Bradley played the 1-4 positions last year and still does that this year.

GETTING IN SHAPE

Redshirt junior post Micayla Buckner lost considerable weight this offseason and has made it a point of emphasis to run the court better, shoot the ball and be an all-conference player. The 6-4 post began her 2017-18 campaign with a career-high 12 points on 6-8 shooting. Her previous high was 10 points, which she accomplished twice last season.

She then scored 20 points versus Texas A&M International in UNT's second game of the year.

She then recorded her first career double-double in their sixth game of the year.

NOVEMBER TO REMEMBER

North Texas won five games before the month of December for only the second time in program history since 1981.

The most games the Mean Green have won before the month of January is 10, which they accomplished in 2005-06 when they started the season 10-2.

BLOCKS

North Texas is averaging 3.4 blocks per game through the first nine games of the year.

They ended last season averaging 2.1 blocks per game.

Redshirt junior Micayla Buckner leads this year's team with 11 blocks on the season. She only had 13 all of last year. Furthermore, her 11 blocks are already more than half as many as Hannah Hopkins had last year who led the team with 16.

Buckner had a career-best four blocks in the Mean Green's game against K-State.

Freshmen Deja Terrell is second on the team with six blocks..

DOUBLE-DOUBLES

With Terriell Bradley's double-double on Tuesday at Indiana, North Texas has had three different players record a double-double this season, which is how many they had all of last year.

Terriell Bradley scored 23 points on Dec. 2 versus Tulsa and 22 points on Dec. 5 versus Indiana.

The 23-point performance was a career-best for Bradley.

It's the second time this season she's had back-to-back 20+ point performances.

Bradley has had four 20-point outings this season, which is one more than she had all of last year when she led the team in scoring averaging 13 points per game.

TURNOVER MARGIN

North Texas is forcing an average of 22.1 turnovers per game while only turning it over 13.3 times per game.

Their +8.78 turnover margin is the 5th best in the country.

Through nine games last season, UNT only had a turnover margin of +2. Furthermore, they were coughing it up an average of 19.1 times per game.

GRACE GOODHART

Junior Grace Goodhart started the first five games of the year for the Mean Green this season after only starting one game all of last year.

Goodhart didn't start versus SMU due to an injury sustained in their game versus Detroit Mercy, but she still played 10 minutes versus the Mustangs.

On Nov. 23 vs. Coastal Carolina, Goodhart set a UNT career-best by scoring 10 points. She also recorded five steals, had three assists and no turnovers in the Mean Green's win.

MIMS' 4TH QUARTER

In the fourth quarter versus Tulsa, freshman point guard Trena Mims scored 10 of her career-high 15 points on 4-4 shooting. Mims' previous career-high was 11 points.

The Muskogee, Oklahoma, native scored 14 of her 15 points vs. Tulsa in the second half.

AD THE REBOUNDER

Sophomore Adrianna Henderson had a career-high five rebounds versus Tulsa and then again against La Salle

She is averaging 2.4 rebounds per game while only playing 14 minutes per game.

Henderson has 22 rebounds on the year. She had 16 all of last year while playing in 18 games.

7 MIN SHUTOUT

North Texas held Coastal Carolina scoreless for the first seven minutes and 40 seconds of their game on Nov. 23rd.

FREE THROW ISSUES (pt. 1)

North Texas shot just 56 percent from the free throw line in the first four games of the season (25-44).

They flipped the script in their fifth game, when they went 19-24 (79.2 percent) from the free throw line.

However since then, the Mean Green have gone back to their struggling ways at the charity stripe only making 50-of-75 (66 percent) in their last four games combined.

UNT has five everyday players shooting under 70 percent at the free throw line this year.

FREE THROW ISSUES (pt 2)

North Texas is being outscored at the free throw line this season 115-94

That gap has decreased over the past few games thanks to less fouls being committed by the Mean Green.

OWNING THE PAINT

North Texas has only been outscored in the paint once this season (at Indiana).

The Hoosiers outscored the Mean Green 38-36 in the paint.

On the year, North Texas has outscored

its first nine opponents in the paint by a combined score of 250-144.

They outscored Texas A&M International 44-2 in the paint in their second game of the year.

44 percent of UNT's points this season have come from inside the paint.

POINTS IN PAINT BY GAME

Nov. 10 vs. MACU, 38-4

UNT takes pride in out working its opponents. Hustle stats are kept by strength and conditioning coach Rich Lefebvre. He also keeps track of the opponents' hustle stats.

Hustle points are awarded for deflections, charges drawn and 50/50 balls (loose-ball recovery). One point for each stat.

Through nine games, UNT has yet to have a game with fewer hustle points than its opponent.

Lauren Holmes leads the Mean Green with 48 hustle points. She has 15 more hustle points than Terriell Bradley who has the second-most.

Through nine games, Holmes has drawn a total of eight charges.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Lauren Holmes was named the C-USA Freshman of the Week on Dec. 11 for the week of Dec. 4-10.

The Fayetteville, Arkansas, native averaged 14 points per game in the two games while shooting 45 percent from the field. She had eight steals in the two games combined, including a season-high five on Saturday versus La Salle.

On defense, Holmes marked Indiana's all-American Tyra Buss throughout and held her to eight points in the second half as the Mean Green made a 15-point comeback.

**Third Year
(North Texas '02)**

Jalie Mitchell begins her third season as head coach of the North Texas women's basketball team.

The Mean Green have seen improvement in each of her first two seasons. She enters her third season with the most road wins and second-most total wins in program history by a coach with two full seasons under their belt.

In her first season in 2015-16, North Texas more than doubled its win total from the previous season and beat the No. 17 ranked Oklahoma Sooners in Oklahoma for their first win of the year. It was the first time a Mean Green team had beaten a ranked opponent in program history.

They proceeded to post a 11-19 record and win five regular season conference games and reach the second-round of the C-USA Championship.

In 2016-17, the Mean Green improved on their overall record by a game and set program records and firsts. They won eight Conference-USA games, the most since joining the conference in the 2013-14 season. They defeated UTEP in El Paso for the first time in program history and they reached the quarterfinals of the C-USA Championship for the first time as well.

North Texas' three-game road winning streak in February of 2017 was its longest road winning streak since the 2001-02 season when Mitchell was a senior at North Texas and its overall five game winning streak in February was the longest since the 2012-13 season..

When hired, Mitchell described North Texas as her dream job. The 2002 Mean Green graduate is the program's greatest player and boasts numerous records as a four-year letter winner. She is the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,764 points and tops the list of career free throws made and attempted. In 2002, Mitchell was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year when she averaged 19.4 points per game.

She earned all-conference honors all four years at North Texas and was a part of the winningest senior class in program history, compiling a 77-39 record -- including a 42-4 mark at the Super Pit -- and making back-to-back WNIT appearances in 2001 and 2002.

Mitchell's No. 44 is one of two women's basketball numbers that has been retired by the Mean Green and her spectacular playing career culminated in 2007 when she was inducted into the North Texas Athletic Hall of Fame.

Under Mitchell, North Texas has had a noticeable increase in offense and defense. In her first season, the Mean Green improved their field goal percentage by 7.23 percent — the largest improvement in the country. It was also the sixth-highest shooting percentage in North Texas history. In total, the Mean Green averaged nearly 10 more points per game in 2015-16 than the year before. In 2016-17, North Texas held conference opponents to 62.9 points per game and typically held the opposition's leading scorer to 10 or more points below their season average.

Prior to becoming the Mean Green's head coach, Mitchell had two stints as an assistant in Denton. Most recently under then head coach Karen Aston for the 2011-12 campaign. In that campaign, the team went 15-16.

When Aston left the Mean Green to coach the University of Texas in 2012, Mitchell followed. In her three seasons at Texas, the team combined for a 60-41 overall record. The Longhorns made the NCAA Tournament field the last two seasons, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2015 -- their first since 2008.

Mitchell began her collegiate coaching career in 2008 as an assistant coach with the Mean Green under Shanice Stephens. She spent two seasons at North Texas under Stephens before taking on the same position at UNC-Wilmington for the 2010-11 season. Mitchell helped the Seahawks finish with a 24-9 record and reach the second round of the WNIT, both program bests.

In addition to the North Texas Athletics Hall of Fame, Mitchell was inducted into the Duncanville ISD Athletic Hall of Honor in October of 2015.

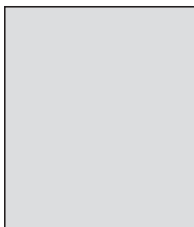

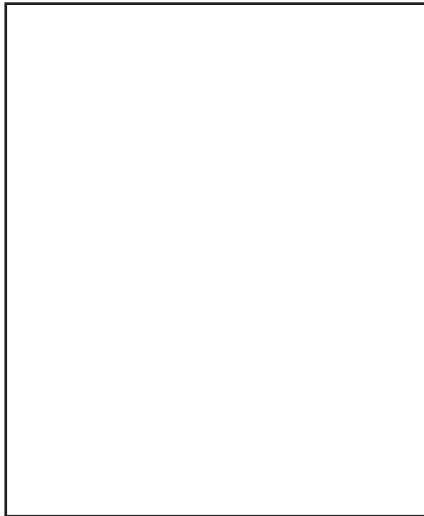
