

North Texas (0-0, 0-0 C-USA) enters the 2017 season after a strong first year under head coach Seth Littrell that saw the Mean Green finish 5-8 and make an appearance in the 2016 Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl. North Texas will take on Football Championship Subdivision foe Lamar (0-0, 0-0- Southland) Saturday at 6 p.m. at Apogee Stadium.

Saturday's game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 with Doug Anderson (pxp) and LaDarrin McLane (analyst) as well as on the Mean Green Radio Network with Dave Barnett (pxp) and Hank Dickenson (analyst). Next Up

The Mean Green travel to face Metroplex rival SMU on Saturday, Sept. 9 at 6 p.m. CT at Gerald J. Ford Stadium in Dallas. That game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 and the Mean Green Radio Network.

Series History

North Texas and Lamar have met six times previously, with the Mean Green winning four of those contests.

Saturday's meeting is the first in 31 years, as North Texas knocked off the Cardinals 33-13 in Beaumont on October 21, 1986.

The last time the pair met in Denton, North Texas blanked the Cardinals 20-0 on November 9, 1985.

Season Openers

North Texas enters Saturday's tilt with a 38-60-3 record in season-openers. North Texas is 6-4 in its last 10 season-openers in Denton, dating back to the 1990 season, when it opened with a 20-7 win over Alcorn State.

Home Openers

The Mean Green enter Saturday's matchup with Lamar with a 3-7 record in their last 10 home openers.

Langston's Lamar Connection

Offensive line coach Chuck Langston is in his first season in Denton in 2017 and kicks off the season against a familiar foe. Langston spent the last five years in his hometown of Beaumont, Texas, with the Cardinals, four in a coaching capacity. Langston was the director of football operations in 2012 before joining the coaching staff in 2013. He also served as Lamar's offensive coordinator/ offensive line coach each of the past two years. Langston's son, Christian is also a freshman deep snapper for the Cardinals.

Creeping Up on 500

The Mean Green picked up their 498th victory in program history on November 19, 2016 when they defeated Southern Miss. With a win Saturday against Lamar, they would be just one win shy of No. 500 as a program.

McClain Leads Mean Green Defense

A preseason All-Conference USA selection for the second consecutive year, senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) garnered second team All-Conference honors in 2016 in Conference USA. For the second straight season, McClain led the team in tackles with 91 (67 solo) to go along with one-and-a-half sacks, five tackles for loss, three interceptions, two forced fumbles and three pass break-ups in 13 appearances.

- * McClain had double-digit tackles four different times in 2016.
- * McClain led the team in tackles in 2015, recording 110 as a sophomore, which ranked in the top 10 nationally.

Wonderful Wilson

Mean Green senior running back Jeffery Wilson (Elkhart, Texas) scored 14 rushing touchdowns in 2016, which was the fourthmost rushing touchdowns in a single season in school history.

Top Five in Single-Season Rushing TDs

- 4. Jeffery Wilson, 2016 14

Wilson finished 2016 with 169 carries for 936 yards, which was a career high for a single season in just 11 games.

- * Wilson now has rushed for 1,990 yards in his career, which places him 11th in school history. Wilson is just 87 yards shy of the 10 spot, which is held by Terrance Brown (2,077 yards).
- * Wilson ranks 12th in school history in rushing touchdowns with 16 in his career and is just one shy of tying the 10 spot, which is currently held by Mitch Maher (1991-94) and Brandin Byrd (2010-13).
- * Wilson was also a factor as a receiver in 2016, catching 29 passes for 247 yards and another score.

Brilliant Brooks

Junior defensive back Nate Brooks (Whitehouse, Texas) was named, along with senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) to the preseason All-Conference team by Conference USA. Brooks had a tremendous campaign in a starting role

at corner last season and led the team and ranked 31st in the country with four interceptions.

- * He was also the team's fourth-leading tackler with 57 stops (36 solo), four picks, four pass break-ups, a sack and a pair of forced fumbles. North Texas only had four interceptions as a team in 2015, a feat that Brooks has equaled by himself.
- * Brooks' four interceptions ranked second in Conference USA (behind only Louisiana Tech's Xavier Woods, who had five).

Fine, Hamilton, Looking To Build On Freshman Campaigns

Sophomore quarterback Mason Fine (Locust Grove, Oklahoma) made nine starts at quarterback as a true freshman a year ago. He completed 155-of-261 passes in his 10 appearances for 1,572 yards with six touchdowns and five interceptions, as well as two rushing touchdowns. Fine was named as Conference USA's All-Freshman quarterback.

Defensive end LaDarius Hamilton (Corrigan, Texas) had nine tackles, three for a loss and a sack on his way to Conference USA All-Freshman honors.

Moore, Moore, Moore

Senior kicker Trevor Moore holds the school record for most consecutive made extra points. The Edmond, Oklahoma, native pushed his school record to 99 straight made PATs after going 4-for-4 in the 2016 Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl. Moore has never missed an extra point attempt in his career. Moore broke the record of 61 that was previously held by Keith Chapman (1987-89) on September 10 in a win over Bethune-Cookman last season

- * Moore finished 2016 41-for-41 and North Texas was just one of two teams in Conference USA to have not missed an extra point (Florida Atlantic)
- * Moore holds the school record for field goal percentage (75.0%) through the first three years of his career. In total, Moore sits atop seven statistical categories in school history heading into his final season in Denton. In addition to field goal percentage in a single season as well as career and most consecutive extra points made, Moore also is the leader in extra point percentage in a single season

as well as career (100%), extra points made in a single game (11 against Nicholls in 2014) and field goals made in a single game (five against SMU in 2014).

* Moore ranks inside the top three in four other North Texas statistical categories, and is fourth among active NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision kickers in consecutive extra points made. The senior looks to wrap his career as the most decorated kicker in North Texas history. His 99 extra points made are second all-time to Nick Bazaldua's (2002-05) 121, and if he maintains his average of 33 more extra points in a season, Moore will finish his career as the all-time leader in that category as well (132).

Senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas) played in 12 games in 2016 and finished with 42 tackles (26 solo) and 5.5 sacks. He was eighth in the conference in sacks and led the team. Wheeler also forced a pair of fumbles on the year.

- * Wheeler plays the jack linebacker position, a North Texas term for a hybrid linebacker and defensive end.
- * Wheeler earned All-Conference honorable mention recognition from C-USA coaches.

Jenkins Looks To Mirror Huge Impact From 2016

North Texas senior corner Eric Jenkins (New Orleans) had the second-most passes defended in Conference USA in 2016, with 13 (10 passes broken up).

- * Jenkins ranked second in C-USA and tied for 21st nationally at 1.18 passes defended per game.
- * The NCAA defines passes defended as

All Smiley(s)

Senior wide receiver Turner Smiley (Frisco, Texas) finished his 2016 season factoring into the Mean Green offense in a big way in the final three games of the regular season. Smiley caught 20 passes for 266 yards and two scores in his last three games played (November 19 vs. Southern Miss, November 26 at UTEP and the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl on December 27), while catching 13 for 123 yards and no scores in his previous eight games.

* Smiley's strongest single game performance was the best by a North Texas receiver last season. He caught seven passes for 162 yards and two touchdowns, which at the time were all career highs, in the win over Southern Miss in Denton. His new career high in catches is eight, after his eight catch, 79 yard performance in the bowl game.

Presto(n)!

Junior nickelback Ashton Preston (Edmond, Oklahoma) finished the 2016 season with 40 tackles (24 solo) with an interception, a sack, four-and-a-half tackles for loss and a forced fumble in 12 appearances.

* Preston shared time at the nickel position with senior Dee Baulkman (Bainbridge, Georgia) last year.

Dee-Lightful

Senior nickelback Dee Baulkman (Bainbridge, Georgia) concluded the 2016 season with 35 tackles (20 solo) with two-and-a-half sacks and five-and-a-half tackles for loss in 12 appearances.

Garner (Mansfield, Texas) had a breakout sophomore season at weakside linebacker in 2016. He posted 50 tackles (32 solo) to go along with three-and-a-half sacks, six tackles for loss, and two fumble recoveries in 12 appearances. He will be counted on in a starting role for the 2017 season.

E.J.'s Big Impact

Junior linebacker E.J. Ejiya was a big part of North Texas' defensive success in 2016 with 43 tackles (26 solo), three-and-a-half of which were for loss on the year in 13 games played.

Quarterback Room

While North Texas returns sophomore quarterback Mason Fine and redshirt junior Quinn Shanbour, the two account for all 11 games played at the division I level by Mean Green quarterbacks. Fine started nine games a year ago, which accounts for all starts in the quarterback room. Junior college transfer Devlin Isadore, redshirt senior Devin O'Hara, and freshmen Mitch Cason (redshirted in 2016) and Cade Pearson have combined for no appearances.

Running Back Depth

The Mean Green return 2016's leading rusher, senior Jeffery Wilson, who had a breakout season last year with 936 yards and 14 touchdowns, but there is also a lot of depth at the position. Redshirt senior Andrew Tucker is a tough runner who made the most of his limited action a year ago, and coaches are very excited about redshirt freshman Nic Smith having an opportunity on the field. Smith finished his high school career as Arlington ISD's all-time leading scorer and the leading rusher in Martin High School's history (3,803 career rushing yards with 66 touchdowns).

Behind that three-headed monster, junior Anthony Wyche returns after showing flashes at times in 2016. A pair of freshmen join the group in Loranger, Louisiana, native Evan Johnson and Duncanville's Tre Siggers each arrive in Denton after standout high school careers.

O-Line Looks To Improve

North Texas' offensive line struggled early in 2016, and despite a big improvement over the course of the season, the group surrendered 43 sacks. The Mean Green return three starters on that unit and have added depth this offseason, in addition to its new offensive line coach, Chuck Langston.

Ending Up Well

The Mean Green enter the 2017 season with a ton of depth at defensive end, which features a large rotation of talented players including: redshirt senior Andy Flusche, senior Tillman Johnson, sophomore LaDarius Hamilton, junior Roderick Young and senior Sid Moore. The depth provides the three-man front the ability to make frequent substitutions and keep them fresh.

Notable Turnaround

First-year head coach Seth Littrell took a team that won just one game in 2015 and led them to a 5-8 record and a bowl berth in his first year. It is only the second time in school history that a first-year head coach took his team to a bowl game, joining Hall of Famer Odus Mitchell, who took his team to the Optimist Bowl in his first year (1946).

Only three teams in 102 years of Mean Green football have had a bigger turnaround in one year, 1966, 1983 and 2013. It is also only the seventh time in school history that a North Texas coach had a +4 win differential from the previous year, and only Hayden Fry did it in his first year prior to Littrell.

- * The five wins for the Mean Green in 2016 were the most since 2013 when the team finished 9-4 with a Heart of Dallas Bowl victory over UNLV (36-14).
- * 2016 marks only the third time in the last 13 seasons that the Mean Green have won five or more games (2004, 2013 and 2016).
- * The four-win improvement for a head coach taking over a new program ranked second in the country behind Central Florida, who was 0-12 during the 2015 season and finished 6-7 with a bowl appearance under Scott Frost last year.
 - There were 29 new head coaches at the FBS level heading into 2016.
- * The three conference wins for the Mean Green in 2016 were the most since 2013 and were an improvement on a 1-7 C-USA season in 2015.
- * The Mean Green finished 2016 3-3 at Apogee Stadium, improving on a 1-5 showing the previous year.
- * North Texas finished 2-4 on the road during the 2016 season, improving on a pair of 0-6 showings in 2014 and 2015.

- North Texas was 11-50 on the road in the last 10 seasons prior to 2016.

Littrell's Second Year Boost

Prior to his arrival in Denton, the now 39-year old Littrell was an offensive coordinator in three different stops throughout his career. Each time his offense hit year two, there was an uptick in total offense and points per game. That is certainly the plan for the Mean Green offense, which was much improved in Littrell's first season at the helm.

When Littrell took over as co-offensive coordinator at Arizona (following a one-year stint as running backs/tight ends coach in 2009), the Wildcats ranked 53rd nationally in scoring at 28.2 points per game, 24th in total offense (439.4 per game) and ninth in passing yardage (307.7 per game). Year two saw the Arizona offense score 2.6 points per game more (30.8), and the team improved to the third-best team in the country in terms of passing yardage (370.8 yards per game), as well as a 37-spot improvement in total offense (465.2).

At Indiana in 2012, the Hoosier offense finished 51st in scoring offense (30.8 points per game), 17th in passing offense (311.2) and 34th in total offense (442.0). The Hoosiers then spiked all the way up to 16th nationally in scoring (38.4 points per

game), increasing their output by 7.6 points each game. The passing yards per game actually decreased in 2013, however the total offensive output increased by 66.5 yards per game, and finished ninth in the nation in that category.

At North Carolina the Tar Heels posted a 6-7 record in Littrell's first season in 2014. ranking 36th nationally in scoring offense at 33.2 points per game, while posting 429.8 yards per game of total offense (45th best in the country) and 278.4 yards per game in passing offense (27th in the nation). The 12 games that followed saw the Heels improve immensely in one of the program's most successful seasons in its history. North Carolina went 11-1 before Littrell's was hired by the Mean Green on the day of the ACC Championship game. An 8.9 points per game jump (41.2 through 12 games) saw the Heels rank 11th in the country at that time. A 65.9 yards per game increase in total offense saw North Carolina leap 29 spots in the national rankings to 16th. Like his second-year squad in Bloomington, Littrell's offense saw a more balanced attack, achieving that total offensive bump with a slightly decreased production in passing yardage per game.

No Close Games

North Texas had only one game last season decided by less than a touchdown – a 29-23 win over Southern Miss on November 19. Each of the 12 other games last season were

decided by a touchdown or more, and nine of them were decided by 14 points or more.

The average margin of victory in games that North Texas won was 13.6 points. The average margin of victory by opponents in Mean Green losses was 16.5 points per game.

Tough Sledding

North Texas faced seven teams last year that played in postseason bowl games. North Texas also played five of the other six league bowl teams in 2016, with Old Dominion being the only Conference USA bowl team that the Mean Green didn't face.

There are six teams that reached bowl games a year ago on the Mean Green's 2017 schedule; Iowa, Southern Miss, UTSA, Old Dominion, Louisiana Tech and Army.

Over the 24 Hump

North Texas was 0-7 in 2016 when scoring 24 points or less and 5-1 when scoring more than 24 points. The Mean Green averaged 37.0 points per game in wins and 17.1 points per game in losses.

Offense Up, Defense Down

North Texas improved both its offensive scoring average and defensive scoring average under first-year head coach Seth Littrell and his staff. In 2015, before Littrell and his staff arrived, the Mean Green scored an average of 15.2 points per game and allowed an

average of 41.2 points per game, a difference of 26.0 points per game, while going 1-11. In 2016, Littrell's first at the helm, North Texas averaged 24.8 points on offense and allowed 32.6 points on defense, a difference of just 7.8 points per game. The improvement was equally impressive for both the offense and defense. The 2016 offense (in 13 games) scored 140 points more than 2015's team while the defense was 71 points better than the 2015 team (12 games).

- * Offensively, the Mean Green ranked 11th nationally in offensive turnaround in points per game compared to 2015 (9.6).
- The Mean Green ranked second in Conference USA and second among teams in the FBS with new head coaches (out of 29) in that category.
- * Defensively, North Texas was 13th nationally in defensive turnaround in points per game compared to 2015 (8.7).
 - The Mean Green ranked first in C-USA and second among teams in the FBS with new head coaches. Only UCF was better at a -13.1 margin, which led the country
- * Seth Littrell's former team, North Carolina, was -8.4 ppg from when he was the offensive coordinator in 2015.

Holding Halftime Leads

In 12 of the Mean Green's 13 games in 2016, the team leading at halftime went on to win the game. The only second-half comeback this season by either team, was when North Texas trailed Rice 17-14 at the half and came back to win 42-35 in double overtime. In the eight losses for North Texas, the Mean Green trailed at the half by less than a touchdown only twice – a three point deficit to Army in the Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl and a six point deficit to Middle Tennessee on October 1. The average lead by North Texas opponents in those eight losses was 13.4 points. In the five wins, the Mean Green led by an average of 7.6 points at the half.

Picks Picked Up

In 2015 the North Texas defense had just four interceptions and finished the season ranked 121st nationally in that category. Only three Mean Green defenders recorded a pick in 2015. Conversely in 2016, seven North Texas defenders recorded at least one

interception and the team total of 14 ranked tied for 35th among all FBS teams. North Texas had at least one interception in each of the first seven games of the season before cooling off and only getting picks in two of its last six games.

Junior defensive back Nate Brooks (Whitehouse, Texas) intercepted four passes to lead the team in 2016, and also equaled the 2015 team total.

Getting Pressure Gets Results

When North Texas was able to get pressure on the quarterback in 2016, it resulted in team success. When the Mean Green had at least three sacks in a game last season, they were 4-1. The only exception to that was the five sacks against UTSA in a loss on October 31. When North Texas had less than three sacks in a game, it was 1-7.

Coming out Cold

The success, or lack thereof, for North Texas during the 2016 season was predictable by the way it came out of the locker room in the first and third quarter. In the five games that the Mean Green won, they averaged 9.0 points in the first quarter and 9.0 points in the third quarter, which was the two highest scoring averages for any of the four quarters. In the eight losses, North Texas averaged 3.5 points in the first quarter and 3.0 points in the third quarter, which were the two lowest scoring quarters in those games.

Points Off Turnovers

North Texas forced 22 turnovers in 2016, including seven against Army on October 22. The Mean Green scored 70 points off of those 22 turnovers, including at least one touchdown off of a turnover in each of its five wins. In those five wins, North Texas forced 16 turnovers and scored 49 points off of those. In the eight losses, North Texas forced just six turnovers and scored 21 points off of those.

What's The Rush?

North Texas scored 24 rushing touchdowns in 2016 as a team, after reaching the end zone only seven time that way in 2015.

Leading the Way

The Mean Green secondary intercepted 14 passes in 2016. Junior corner Nate Brooks (Whitehouse, Texas) led the team with four, while senior safety Kishawn McClain (Rosenberg, Texas) and senior corner Eric

Jenkins (New Orleans) each had three, and junior nickel Ashton Preston (Edmond, Oklahoma) and sophomore defensive back Khairi Muhammad (Dallas, Texas) each had one.

- * North Texas returns 85.7 percent of its interceptions from a year ago (12-of-14)
- * North Texas was second in Conference USA in interceptions (Charlotte led the way with 16), and the Mean Green tied for 35th nationally.
- * The Mean Green only intercepted four passes as a team in 2015.
- * The Mean Green ranked as the best in the conference in passing-defense efficiency (123.9) in 2016.

UNT Second in C-USA in Pass Defense in 2016

The Mean Green ranked second in Conference USA in pass defense last season, allowing just 200.2 yards per game, trailing only Southern Miss.

- * Opponents completed just 51.4 percent of passes against the Mean Green in 2016, which was tops in the conference by a margin of over three percent.
- * North Texas only allowed 20 passing touchdowns in 13 games in 2016, which was the second fewest allowed in Conference USA.

Mean Green Second in Opponent 4th Downs in 2016

North Texas was the second best team in Conference USA at holding opponents on fourth downs, allowing conversions at a 40.7 percent clip.

* That ranked 27th in the country

Spreading It Around

North Texas had six players with over 20 catches and five with 25 or more in 2016. Former wide receiver Thaddeous Thompson (Cibolo, Texas) led the way with 40 receptions.

Senior receiver Turner Smiley (Frisco) is the team's leading returning receiver, as he caught 33 balls for 389 yards and tied for a team-high two touchdowns.

Mean Green Return Five All-Conference Honorable Mention Players

Five Mean Green student-athletes that earned honorable mention recognition from Conference USA for their performance in 2016 return in 2017. Junior offensive lineman Jordan Murray (Coppell), senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas), senior defensive back Eric Jenkins (New Orleans), junior defensive back Nate Brooks (Whitehouse, Texas), senior kicker Trevor Moore (Edmond, Oklahoma) each were named All-Conference honorable mention by C-USA coaches last season.

Sack City

The Mean Green's 26 sacks in 2016 were seven more than they recorded in 2015 (19) and 16 different players had at least half a sack.

* Senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler led the team with 5.5 sacks, on his way to a Conference USA All-Conference honorable mention nod last year.

Harrell Moves Upstairs

Offensive coordinator Graham Harrell has made the decision to transition from an onfield position up into the press box for his second year in charge of the Mean Green offense.

What's In A (Nick) Name?

A trio of defensive players in Denton have some pretty interesting nicknames. Redshirt junior defensive tackle Ulaiasi Tauaalo (Keller, Texas) is affectionately known as Toala Bear, sophomore defensive lineman LaDarius Hamilton (Corrigan, Texas) goes by Hambone and senior linebacker Joshua Wheeler (Grand Prairie, Texas) is nicknamed Earl.

Texas-Made

There are currently 91 players on the North Texas roster who are from the state of Texas. 29 players are not from the Lone Star State, and the next highest representation comes from the north in Oklahoma, with eight.

Second Year → Oklahoma '01

The University of North Texas named Seth Littrell as its 19th head football coach, University President Neal Smatresk announced on December 5, 2015

Littrell, now 39, led the Mean Green to the second-best turnaround in the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2016, his first season at the helm. North Texas improved its win total by four games, finishing 5-8 on the season with a

Zaxby's Heart of Dallas Bowl appearance. Littrell helped lead the Mean Green to a 9.6 points per game jump in scoring offense from it's output in 2016, which ranked 11th-best in the nation, and the 2016 defense allowed 8.7 points per game fewer than it did in 2015, which was the 13th-best turnaround in the country.

One of the brightest offensive minds in college football, Littrell came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach for offense and tight ends at North Carolina. At the time of his hire, the Muskogee, Oklahoma, native was the youngest coach in Conference USA and fifth youngest in the nation.

North Carolina scored over 30 points nine times in 2015, topped the 40-point mark seven times and scored over 50 points in four games, which is a school record. Through 12 games, UNC averaged 41.2 points a game, which was 11th in the nation.

Under the guidance of Littrell, quarterback Marquise Williams set a new school record for career touchdowns (90) and total offense at North Carolina.

In 2015 with Littrell, the UNC offense averaged 7.46 yards per play, which was second in the nation, and ran the ball for 6.0 yards a carry, which ranked third in the country. UNC was one of just 11 schools in the nation averaging more than 200 yards rushing (229.7) and 250 yards passing (266.0). UNC rushed for over 200 yards eight times and had over 500 yards of total offense in four games in 2015, including 704 yards in a 66-31 win over Duke.

In his first season in Chapel Hill in 2014, Littrell helped Carolina establish several school records, including most passing yards, most passing touchdowns and most first downs. Williams was a second-team all-conference pick after leading the Tar Heels to a bowl game in his first year as the starter, and set several individual school records, including most rushing yards and rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. Carolina gained more than 5,000 yards in Littrell's first season as the play-caller and averaged 429.8 yards per contest.

Littrell came to Chapel Hill from Indiana where he guided one of the most prolific offenses in the country. Indiana finished ninth in the nation in total offense in 2013, averaging 508.5 yards per game. The Hoosiers were 17th in passing offense (306.7 avg.) and 30th in rushing offense (201.8). Indiana was one of only three teams to average more than 300 yards passing and 200 yards rushing

Under Littrell's guidance in 2013, Indiana set single-season records with 6,102 total yards, (508.5 ypg), 461 points, (38.4 ppg), 36 passing touchdowns, 62 total touchdowns and 300 first downs. Tight end Ted Bolser thrived in his system, setting IU career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns by a tight end. Bolser and wide receiver Cody Latimer were selected in the 2014 NFL Draft. Latimer was taken in the second round (56th overall) by the Denver Broncos, while Bolser went in the seventh round to Washington.

In Littrell's first season as Indiana's offensive coordinator in 2012, the Hoosiers led the Big Ten and ranked 17th nationally in passing offense (311.2). They finished second in the conference in total offense (442.0) and fourth in scoring offense (30.8).

Prior to his stint at Indiana, Littrell coached three seasons at Arizona, where his 2011 offense ranked third nationally in passing offense (370.8) and 15th in total offense (465.2).

Three of his Arizona players were selected in the NFL draft: tight end Rob Gronkowski (New England - 2010 second round), quarterback Nick Foles (Philadelphia - 2012 third round) and wide receiver Juron Criner (Oakland - 2012 fifth round).

Prior to Arizona, Littrell served four years as running backs coach at Texas Tech (2005-08) under Mike Leach. The 2008 Red Raiders rushed for 119 yards per game, the highest total in the Leach era. Running back Shannon Woods earned All-Big 12 Conference honors in 2006 after averaging 6.1 yards per carry and snagging 75 receptions, totaling a top 15 national figure of 139 all-purpose yards per game.

Littrell began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Kansas from 2002-04. The Jayhawks played in the 2003 Tangerine Bowl.

Littrell has coached in eight bowl games, played in two and was team captain on Oklahoma's 2000 national championship team. He was a four-year letterwinner at Oklahoma where he rushed for 231 yards and seven touchdowns in 1999 and finished his career with 11 rushing scores.

The Muskogee, Oklahoma, native graduated from Oklahoma with a degree in communications in 2001. Littrell and his wife, Becca, have a son, Tripp, and a daughter, Elle.
